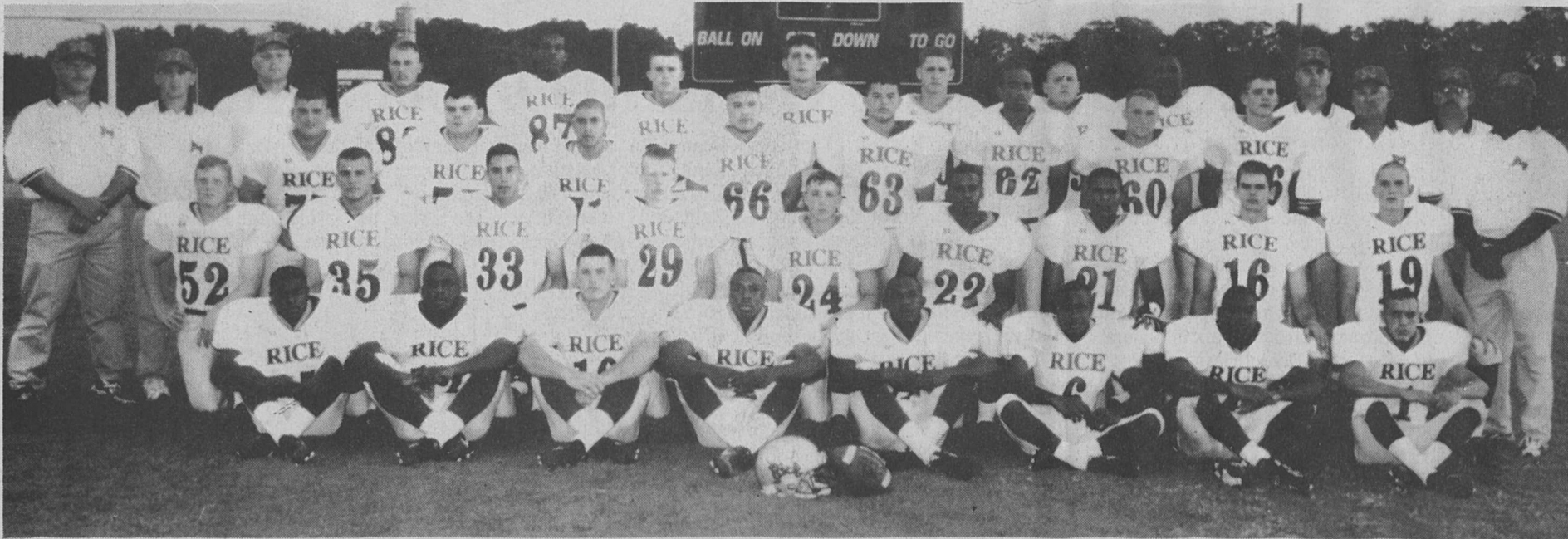

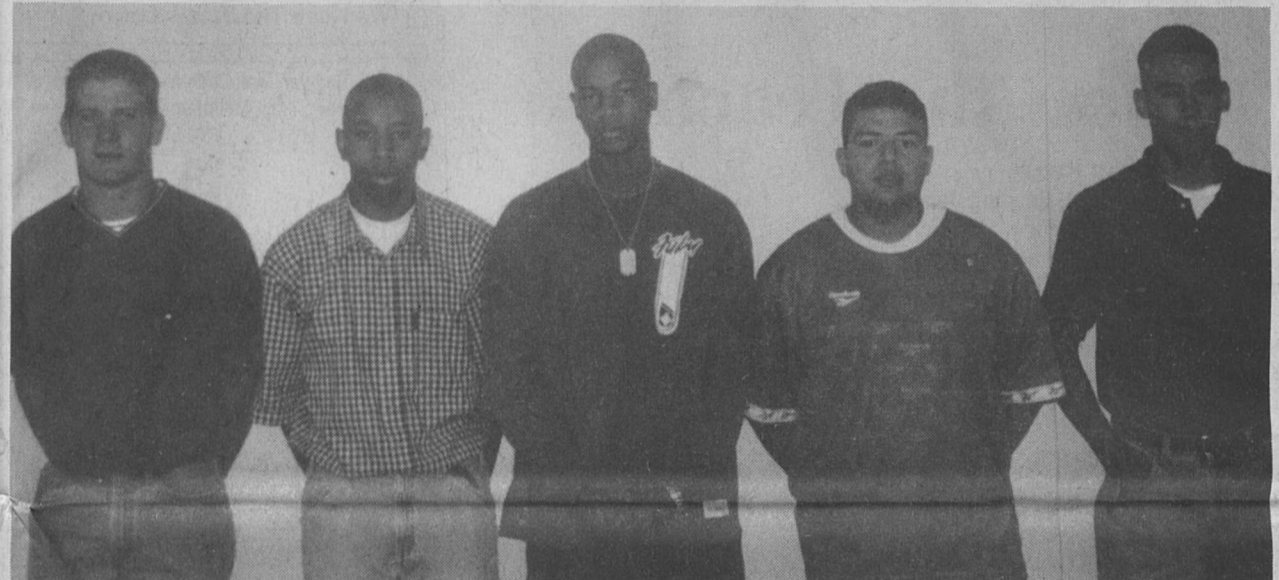
1999 Non-varsity Football Team

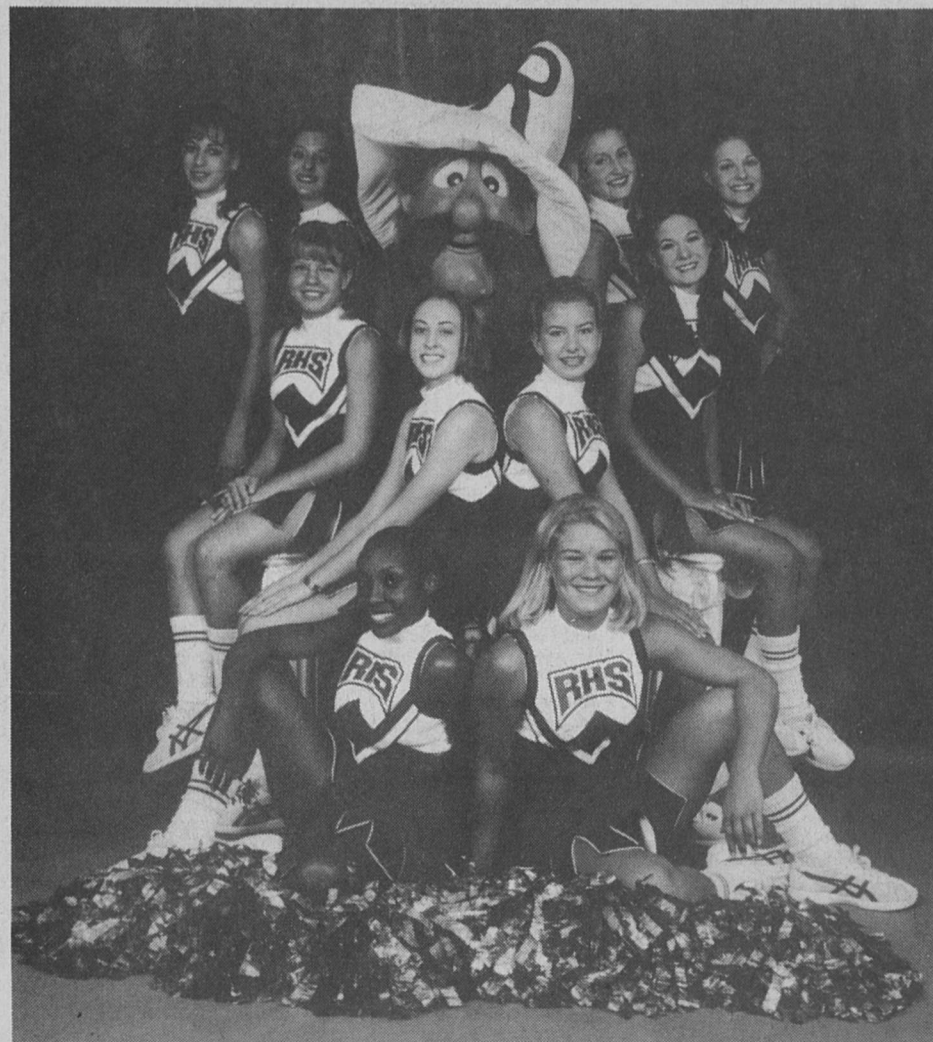
