## Free hearing tests being offered Nov. 1-5

In response to a National Council on Aging (NCOA) study recommending that people who suspect they have a hearing loss seek appropriate screening and diagnosis, Harold L. Griffin, M.D. in Columbus will conduct a special one-time series of free Hearing Health Screenings.

Provided as a public service by the Ear, Nose and Throat Clinics professional staff, the screenings are designed to measure the degree and type of hearing loss of people over 50, many of who have had their hearing damaged by loud noises.

"Because hearing loss builds gradually over time, many people slowly learn to cope with their loss without realizing the damage it may be doing," said Ruth Terry, BC-HIS of Griffin's office.

The NCOA study shows that untreated hearing loss may be a more serious problem than many realize, often leading to depression, anxiety, paranoia and emotional turmoil. By conducting the screenings, Dr. Griffin

and Ruth hope to make it easier for people to address their hearing loss before it becomes more serious.

Interested Texans should call 1-800-445-5062 (in Columbus, 409-732-5791) to schedule an appointment for a free screening, which will be available Monday, Nov. 1, thru Friday, Nov. 5, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day.

The screenings, which will be conducted by appointment at Griffin's office at 1221 Bowie in Columbus, are supported in part by a grant from Oticon Inc., manufacturer of the Digifocus line of digital hearing instruments.

"Denial, embarrassment or frustration are among the reasons many people hesitate to seek help for hearing loss," notes Ruth.

"These simple, painless screenings may provide the incentive for those who struggle with hearing loss to finally take action. There have been remarkable advances in hearing instrument including smaller size instruments." (See Hearing, Page 4)
