## Licenses

through 499 acres; \$100 for 500 through 999 acres; \$200 for 1,000 acres or more. Required of anyone who leases hunting rights or charges a fee for hunting on property they own or property they control.

•**Hunting Cooperative Lease License** (Types 182 & 183).

Landowners in a county may pool their acreage licensed as a hunting lease to form a "hunting cooperative" in which the leasing profits are distributed to the landowners according to the landowners' participation.

License fee: \$60 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is less than 10,000 acres; \$120 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is between 10,000 and 50,000 acres; and \$240 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is more than 50,000 acres.

•**Wildlife Management Association Area Hunting Lease License** (Types 195, 196 & 197)

A Wildlife Management Association may obtain a special hunting lease license. License fee: \$30 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is less than 10,000 acres; \$60 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is between 10,000 and 50,000 acres; and \$120 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is more than 50,000 acres.

\*Non-residents under 17 years of age are considered as residents and may purchase the Special Resident Hunting Licenses (Type 102).

### HUNTING STAMP FEES

•**Collector Smp Set** (Type 555): \$20. All eight Texas picture stamps (five hunting, two fishing, 1 non-game) for collectors. Not valid for hunting or fishing. Can be purchased at any license sales location and will be received by mail. Individual stamps are not for sale from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.

•**Archery Stamp Fee** (Type 135): \$7

Required of residents and non-residents who hunt deer or turkey during the Archery-Only open season.

•**Muzzleloader Hunting Stamp Fee** (Type 187): \$10

Required of residents and non-residents who hunt with a muzzleloader weapon during the special muzzleloader-only deer season.

•**Texas Waterfowl Stamp Fee** (Type 139): \$7

Required of residents and non-residents who hunt waterfowl (ducks, geese, brant and coot). A valid federal Duck Stamp also required of waterfowl hunters 16 years of age or older.

•**Turkey Stamp Fee** (Type 119): \$5; required of residents and non-residents who hunt turkey. Non-residents that purchase the Non-resident Spring Turkey License are exempt from this stamp requirement.

•**White-winged Dove Stamp Fee** (Type 126): \$7; required of residents and non-residents who hunt white-winged doves.

•**Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp** ("Duck Stamp"): \$15; required for all waterfowl hunters 16 years of age or older; available at most U.S. Post Offices, all Texas Parks & Wildlife offices and some license deputies. The stamp must be signed on its face by the person using it. A valid hunting license and a valid Texas Waterfowl Stamp fee is also required.

•**Federal Sandhill Crane Hunting Permit** (Type 590): FREE; required of all sandhill crane hunters; available at all license deputy sales locations. All permittees should keep a record of hunts and harvests because 26% of permit holders will be chosen for a federal harvest survey.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** No STATE stamp fees are required for any resident or non-resident under 17 years old.
