The Clifton Tyler Club concentrates its hunts in the Eagle Lake/Garwood area. All drives to the morning hunts are no more than 30 minutes.

Our hunting club stresses **QUALITY HUNTING**.

We lease about 40,000 acres of rice land scattered across Colorado County. This allows us the mobility to follow the concentrations.

We can accommodate up to sixty (60) hunters. Our minimum per party is four (4), with a guide for *EACH* party. We do not mix parties. We hunt daily from legal shooting time until noon.

We provide full service reservations. With one call to Ida or Clifton Tyler, we can arrange all of the following:
