Interment was held privately. C.P. Bannon Mortuary of California was in charge of arrangements.

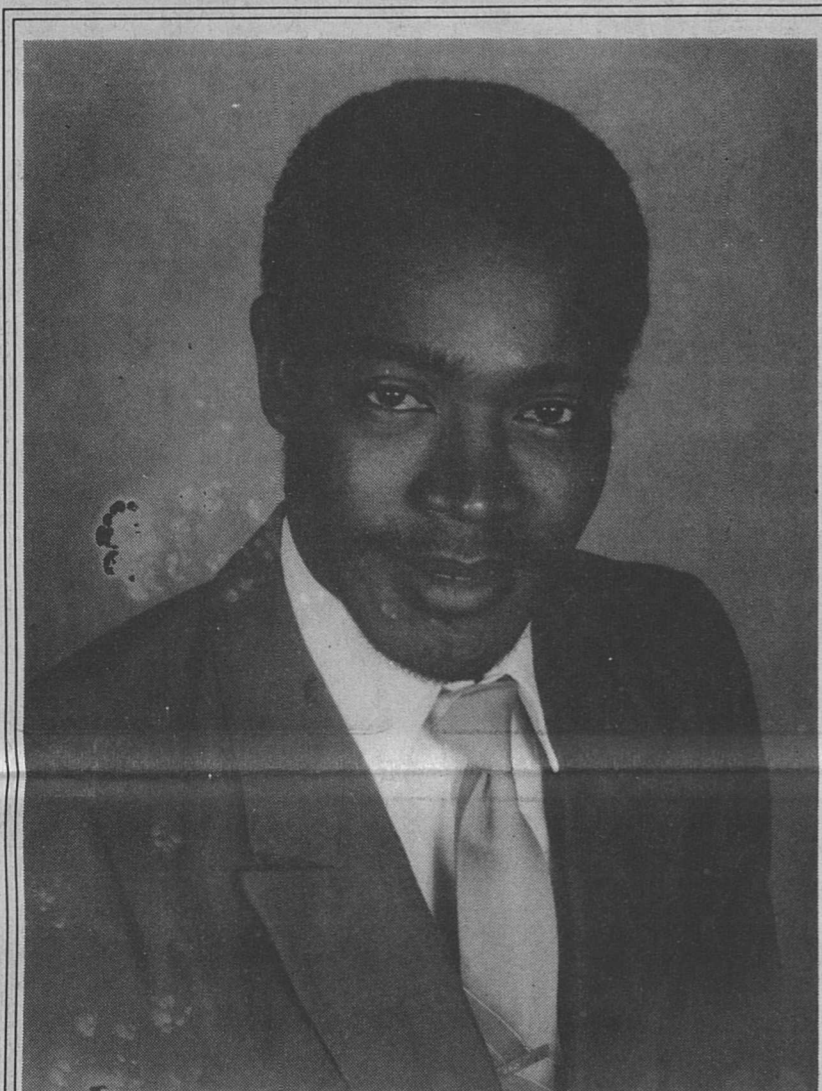
