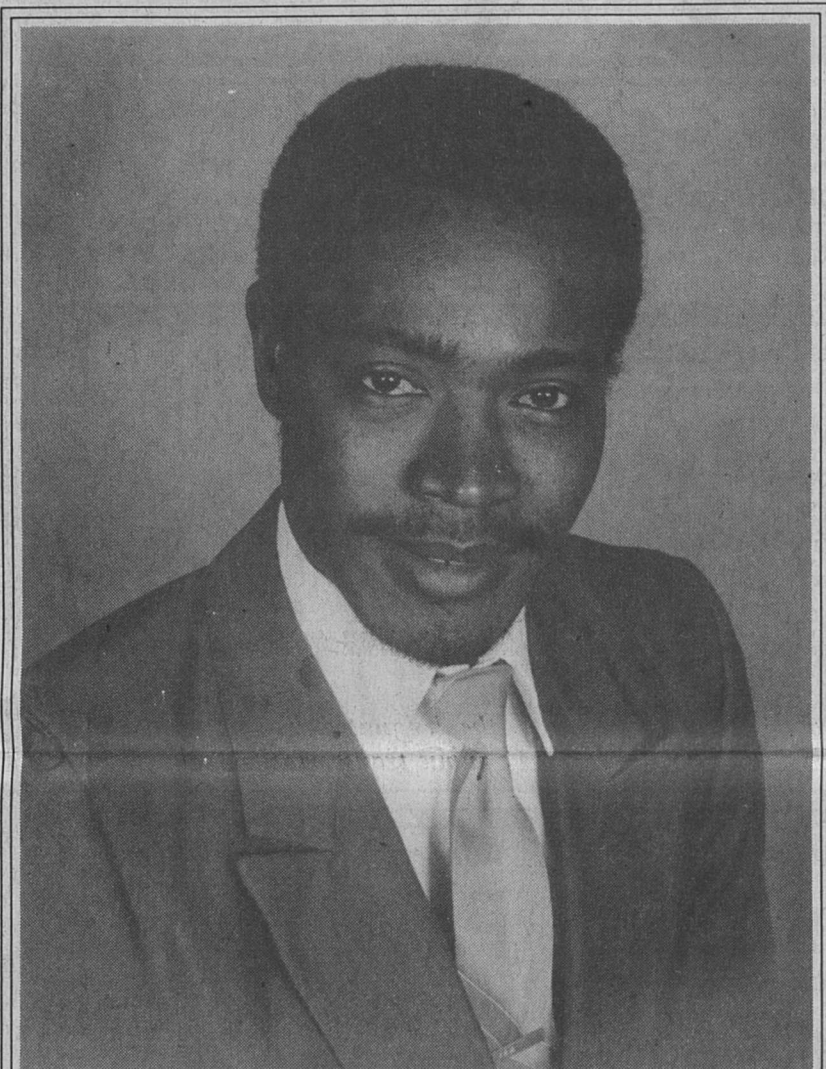

### Head Lice Becoming Resistant to Common Medicines

Health experts are discovering what parents and physicians have suspected for years. Head lice are becoming resistant to many nonprescription lice-killing agents. Head lice infestation, which is common in school-age children, is more likely to be treated in the US than it is in developing countries. Hence, lice in the US are less easily killed by products containing permethrin (Nix) or pyrethrins (Rid, Clear, Pronto). Still, many US health experts recommend the use of these relatively safe agents.

■ Head lice infestation can be avoided by not sharing articles that touch the hair and scalp — including combs, brushes, caps, hats, helmets, and headphones.

■ When using any product intended for head lice, carefully follow directions on the container.

■ When products containing permethrin or pyrethrins fail to kill head lice, some physicians recommend a preparation that contains malathion (Ovide). Malathion is more toxic than permethrin or pyrethrins and must be used carefully.

■ After treatment with any head lice product, combing the wet, well-conditioned hair with a fine-toothed comb helps remove lice eggs.

■ Do not use kerosene or any product intended for use on pets or other animals to kill head lice in humans.
