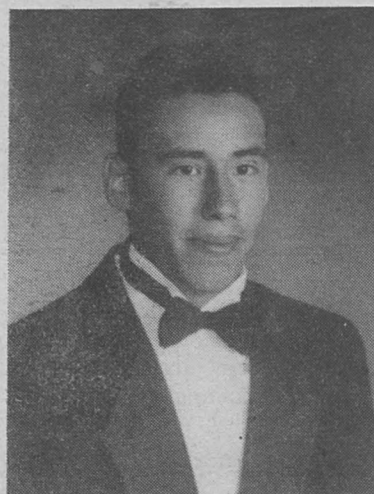
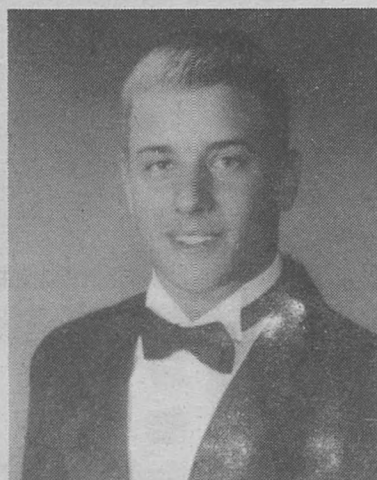

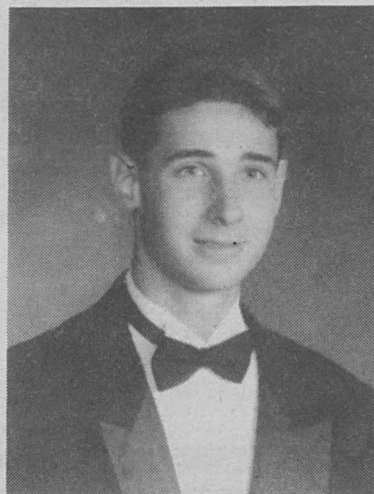
Brett R. Boenisch

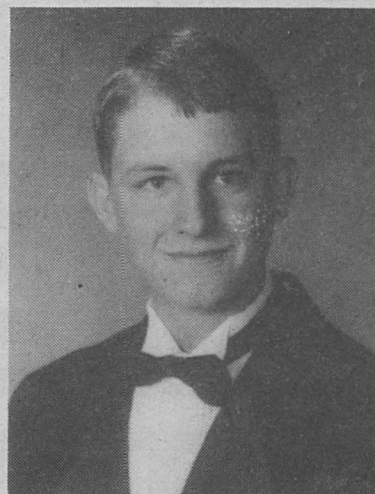
...is the daughter of Lucy Capps of Eagle Lake and the late Jerry W. Capps.

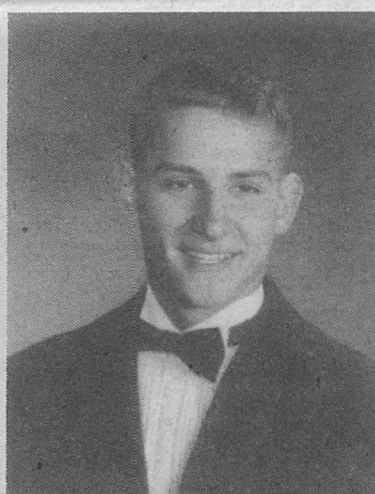

Maria was Cosmetology president and H.O.M.E. Club vice president while at Rice. She won first place in state VICA competition in 1999.

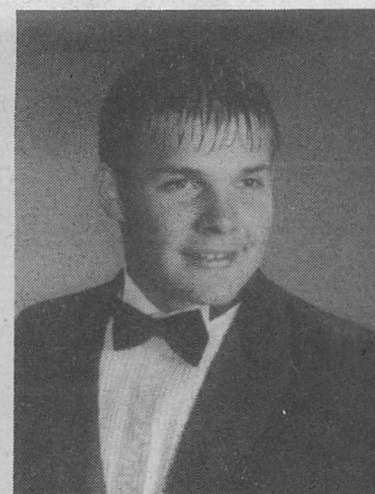
She plans to attend Wharton County Junior College to major in either health information technology or office administration.
