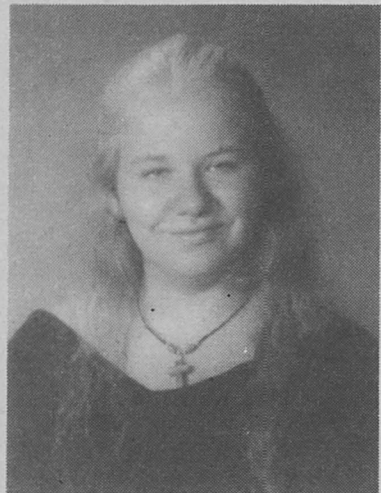


Wharton County Junior College, then transfer to the University of North Texas where plans to major in music performance with a goal of becoming a recording artist and performing with various musicians.



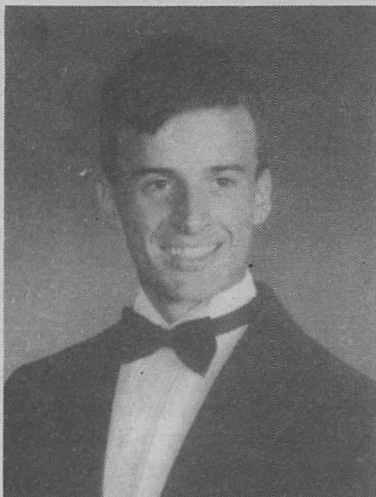
Virginia L. Edds

...is the daughter of Derral Keith and Patricia Sue Edds of Sheridan.

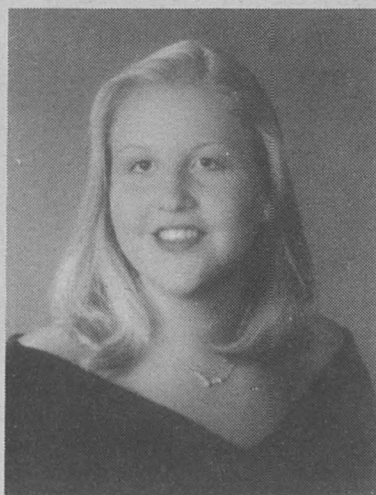
She was a member of Future Teachers of American and its District III president and participated in UIL Headline Writing, taking second place in district in 1998 and third place in 1999.

Amanda was a member of the FTA for four years, serving as its vice president as a junior, presi-

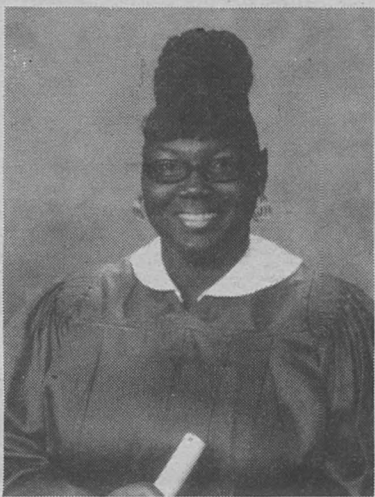
dent as a senior, and District AAA secretary as a senior; a member of the Raider Band for four years, serving as its historian as a junior and parliamentarian as a senior.

After graduation, she plans to attend Houston Community College, then transfer to the University of Houston.

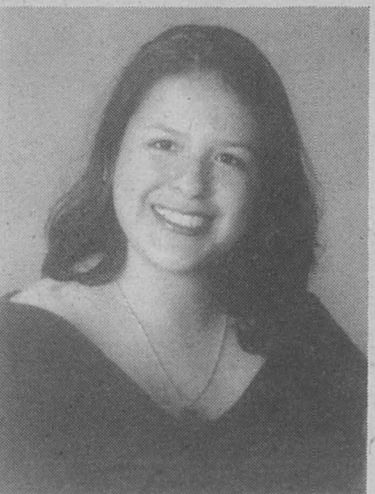
