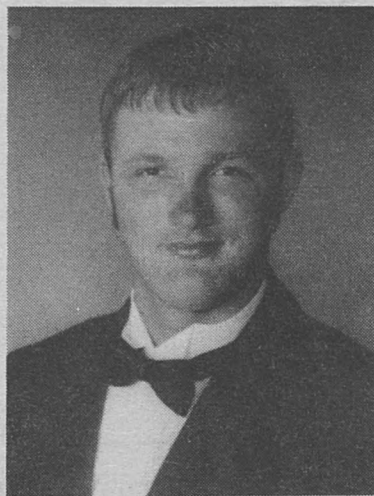


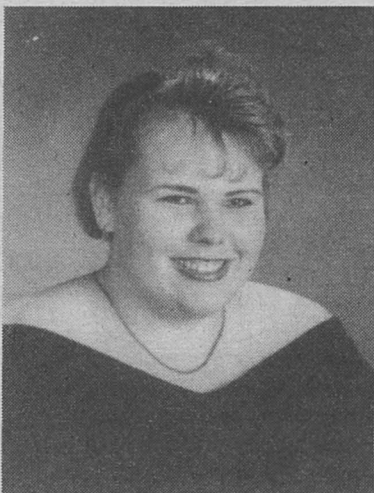
**William Robert Ishee**

He played basketball for three years and was selected Most Adventurous as a senior.

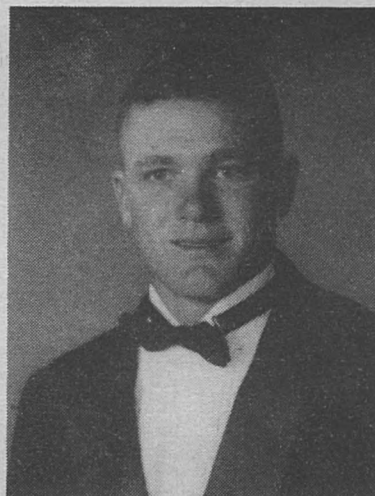
Bill plans to attend college after graduation, but has no definite plans at this time.

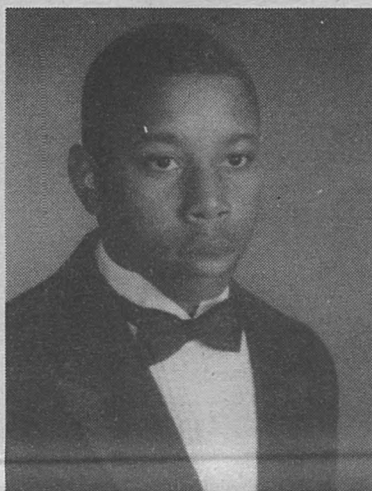
She was a class officer for three years, serving as freshman and sophomore class reporter and junior class president.

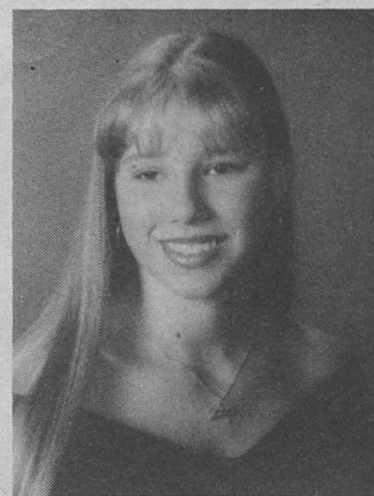
**Tremaine Y. McGrew**

**Julie M. Mixon**

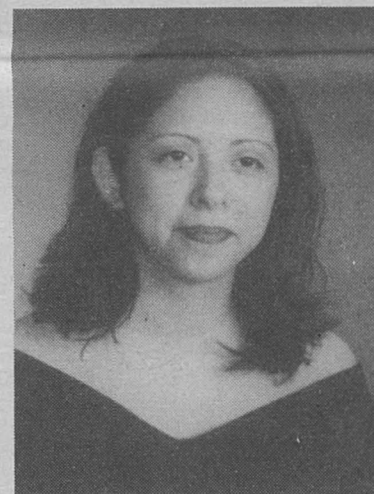
...is the daughter of Dianne Morgan Mixon of Eagle Lake.

Before coming to Rice, while at Waltrip High School in Houston, she was a member of the Rambling Roses Drill and Dance teams as a freshman and sophomore.

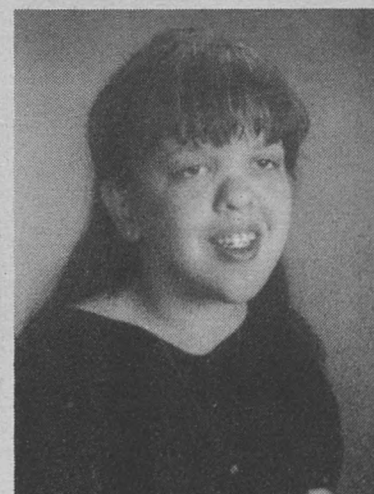
Following graduation, Julie plans to move back to Houston and attend North Harris County Community College to major in management.

**Jennifer A. Navarro**

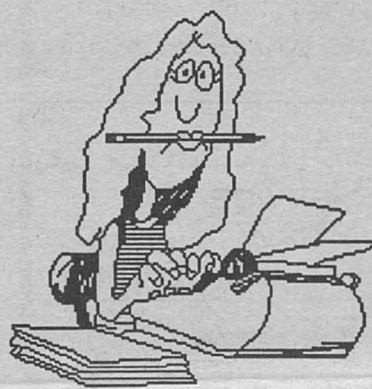
...is the daughter of Effie and Mateo Navarro of Eagle Lake.

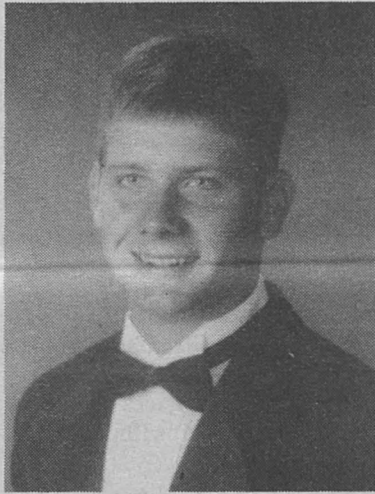
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**Klint R. Korenek**
