Heat precautions include: Never leave anyone, including pets, in a closed, parked vehicle. • Drink plenty of fluids, but avoid drinks with alcohol, caffeine or a lot of sugar. Start drinking fluids before going out into the heat. • Take frequent breaks when working outside. • If you do not have air conditioning at home, go to a mall or other public place with air conditioning. • Check frequently on people who are elderly, ill or shut in. Check with a doctor about the effects of the sun and heat exposure when taking certain prescription drugs, especially diuretics or antihistamines. • At first signs of heat illness-dizziness, nausea, headaches, muscle cramps-move to a cooler place, rest a few minutes, then slowly drink a cool beverage.
