The second annual reunion of the descendants, families and friends of Mr. & Mrs. Robert Johnson, both

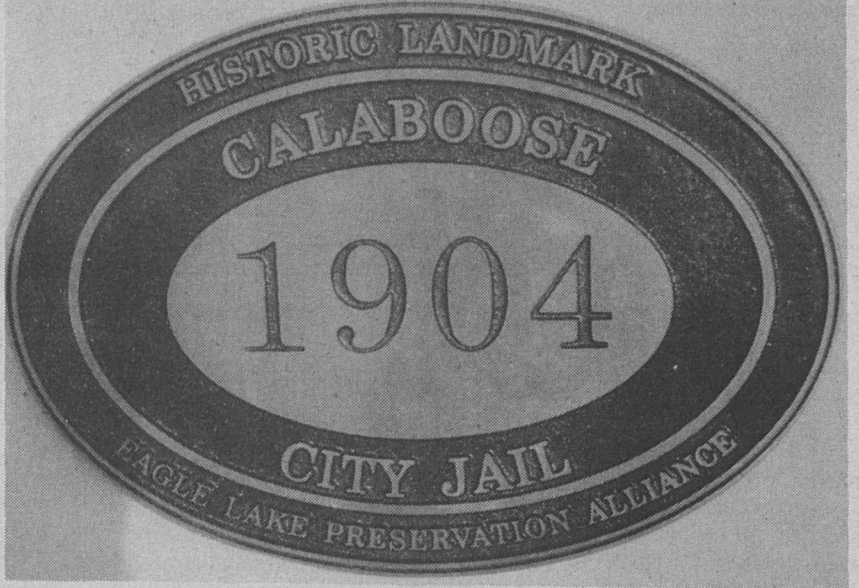

Don't forget to add immunizations to your child's back-to-school list. Students must be up-to-date on state-required vaccinations before the first day of school. Required vaccinations for school-age children include:

- Chicken Pox
- Hepatitis B
- Meningitis
- Hepatitis A (only children in 32 border counties)
- Polio
- DPT (Diphtheria, Whooping Cough and Tetanus)
- Tuberculosis skin test
- MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)
