Other cities in the Eagle Lake area, the amount of their sales tax rebate this month along with the change from the same month last year are:

Columbus, \$81,104.87, down 7.63%; Weimar, \$15,443.08, down 18.49%; Sealy, \$102,466.68, down 31.14%; Bellville, \$59,617.16, +33.35%; El Campo, \$176,075.46, down 12.48%; and Wharton, \$130,954.71, +13.45%.

Year-to-date for the above cities and the change from last year are:

Columbus, \$518,873.62, -4.68%;

Weimar, \$103,466.73, +2.18%; Sealy, \$762,630.00, -8.84%; Bellville, \$304,326.76, +16.23%; El Campo, \$1,351,504.18, +6.49%; and Wharton, \$749,326.96, +4.99%.

On the county level, Colorado County received \$61,133.51, down 23.75%. Austin County received \$95,493.75, down 16.33%. Wharton County received \$144,282.85, up 2.28%.

Year-to-date figures for these counties are: Colorado, \$419,520.36, down 5.13%; Austin, \$583,385.04, -9.69%; Wharton, \$976,558.93, +12.11%.

Due to the Labor Day holiday, the Comptroller's next sales tax allocation is scheduled for Monday, Sept. 11.
