

# Hunting, fishing license cover various time spans

## GENERAL LICENSE INFORMATION

All license sales locations (over 3,000) now carry all of the items listed below since licenses/stamps/Conservation Passports and replacements are electronically printed at time of purchase. Renewals by mail from TPWD Austin or visits to TPWD offices are no longer necessary to purchase Annual Public Hunting Permits and other recreational items.

License sales by phone at no extra charge are available by calling 1-800-TX LIC 4 U (1-800-895-4248) 24 hours a day, with approved VISA or MasterCard. The license is immediately authorized and purchaser can use license/stamp immediately, without waiting to receive an actual paper license by mail (except not valid for deer or turkey hunting due to tag requirements).

All sport fishing and hunting licenses and stamps issued by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department are valid during the license year that began Sept. 1 or the date issued through Aug. 31, 2001.

Licenses issued for a specific number of days, Lake Texoma fishing licenses, Conservation Passports, lifetime licenses and temporary hunting licenses have different expiration dates.

Stamps for hunting and fishing privileges are now a validation printed on the license at time of purchase.

Traditional picture stamps are

now a validation printed on the license at time of purchase. Traditional picture stamps are not valid for hunting or fishing, but continue to be available for collectors.

**Collector Stamp Set (Type 555):** Includes all eight Texas picture stamps (five hunting, two fishing, 1 nongame) for collectors. Can be purchased at any license sales location and will be received by mail. Individual stamps are not for sale from the Texas Parks and Wildlife.

**•Lost/Destroyed License/Stamp**  
Any type of license or stamp that has been lost or destroyed can be replaced at any license sales location by signing an Application for Replacement License. Fees vary from \$1 to \$6.

### It is against the law to:

- hunt or fish without a valid license, or a permit and stamp, on your person and available for inspection by a game warden, unless except by age.
- use another person's license to hunt or fish.
- let someone else hunt or fish with your license.
- purchase more than one resident hunting license per year.
- purchase more than one General Non-Resident Hunting License.
- purchase more than one Non-Resident Spring Turkey Hunting License.
- purchase a general Non-Resident Hunting License and a Non-Resident Spring Turkey Hunting

## LICENSE INFORMATION

A hunting license is required of any person, regardless of age, who hunts any animal or bird in this state, except an alligator hunting license is required to hunt alligators. A hunting license is not needed to hunt furbearing animals if the hunter possesses a trapper's license. Non-residents under 17 years of age may purchase the Special Resident Hunting License (Type 102).

Every hunter (including out-of-state hunters) born on or after Sept. 2, 1971, must successfully complete a Hunter Education Training Course. If you were born on or after Sept. 2, 1971, and you are:

- Age 17 and over; you must successfully complete a Hunter Education Course.
- Age 12 through 16, you must successfully complete a Hunter Education Course or be accompanied by a licensed hunter 17 years of age or older.
- Under 12 years of age, you must be accompanied by a person 17 years of age or older licensed to hunt in Texas.

Minimum age of certification is 12 years and cost of certification is \$10. Proof of certification is required to be on your person while hunting. For course information or exemptions, please contact your local TPW Law Enforcement office; call toll-free 1-800-792-1112 (menu 6) or call 512-

## SPECIAL LICENSES

**•Resident Combination Hunting & Fishing License (Type 100):** \$32

Valid for both hunting and fishing for Texas residents only.

**•Resident "Super Combo" License Package (Type 111):** \$49

Package includes Resident Combination Hunting and Fishing license and 7 state stamp fees (5 hunting, 2 fishing) at a discount price. \$82 value if items purchased separately.

**•"The Texan" All-Purpose Resident License Package (Type 500):** \$100; package adds free park entry (Gold Texas Conservation Passport) to Super Combo above and may include preferred customer opportunities.

## LIFETIME LICENSES

**•Lifetime Resident Combination Hunting & Fishing:**

\$1000; **Lifetime Resident Hunting:** \$600; **Lifetime Resident Fishing:** \$600

Residents may buy hunting and fishing licenses valid for the lifetime of the license holder. The lifetime license exempts the holder from state stamp requirements. Applications for lifetime licenses may be obtained only from Texas Parks & Wildlife offices or by calling 1-800-792-1112.

## HUNTING LICENSES

**SPECIAL NOTE:** A hunting license is required of any person, regardless of age, who hunts in this state. Non-residents under 17 years of age are considered as residents and may purchase the Special Resident Hunting License. No STATE stamp fees are required for any resident or non-resident under 17 years of age.

**•Resident Hunting (Type 101):** \$19; required of any resident (See Licenses, Page 4)
