**Annual Public Hunting Permit (Type 173):** \$40; youth under 17 FREE with permitted adult. Over 1 million acres, approximately 200 areas, and many that are open year-round. Hunt deer, turkey, javelina, feral hogs, squirrel, quail, waterfowl, pheasants, rabbits, furbearers and more. Over 100 special dove hunting areas. Annual Public Hunting Permits are available at all license sales locations (map booklets of the hunting areas and camping information will be mailed within days of purchase, or immediately available when purchased at TPW offices).

**Drawn Hunts:** Drawings for Special Permits for high quality supervised hunts. Alligator, antelope, archery deer, gun deer, exotics, feral hog, javelina and turkey. \$2-\$10 per person per application fee (youth under 17 apply FREE

with adult); \$50-\$100 permit fee is drawn for 1 to 4 days hunts (youth listed on drawn applications hunt free). Anyone may enter.

**Application deadlines for Special Drawing Hunts are:** alligator, Aug. 4; archery deer, archery exotic and pronghorn, Aug. 18; gun deer, Sept 8; later for exotic, feral hog, javelina and turkey.

**Daily Permit Hunts:** A \$10 Daily Hunting Permit purchased at the hunting area is available at some of the Public Hunting Areas (youth under 17 FREE with permitted adult). This information is found in the Applications for Drawings on Public Hunting Lands booklet. Dove, quail, water-

fowl, squirrel, pheasant, rabbit and frogs are designated times on designated WMAs. Some hunts are youth only hunts where only supervised youth are allowed to hunt.

### TEXAS BIG GAME AWARDS PROGRAM

Texas Big Game Awards Program (TBGA) is designed to recognize:

- (1) Management efforts of land managers,
- (2) Importance of hunting as a wildlife management tool,
- (3) A hunter's first lifetime harvest of a big game animal in the state of Texas, and,
- (4) Quality of big game animals harvested in Texas.

The TBGA includes pronghorn antelope, mule deer and white-tailed deer legally harvested in Texas. Land managers option-

ally may be recognized for scored entries. Entries must be scored by a TBGA certified scorer and must meet or exceed regional minimum scores. All program entries must be postmarked prior to Feb. 15. Regional awards banquets will be held in the spring to honor the animals, hunters, landowners and land managers. TBGA is co-sponsored by Texas Parks and Wildlife and Texas Wildlife Association (TWA).

### HUNTING STAMP FEES

Special Note: No STATE

stamp fees are required for any resident or non-resident under 17 years of age, or holders of Lifetime Resident Combination or Lifetime Resident Hunting Licenses.

**Archery Stamp Fee (Type 135):** \$7; required of residents and non-residents who hunt deer or turkey during the Archery-Only open season.

**Muzzleloader Hunting Stamp Fee (Type 187):** \$10; required of residents and non-residents who hunt with a muzzleloader weapon during the special muzzleloader-only deer season.

**Texas Waterfowl Stamp Fee (Type 139):** \$7; required to hunt waterfowl (ducks, teal, mer-


