Hacienda de los Gansos consists of a 2,100 square foot lodge which features a rock fireplace, television and telephone, and separate sleeping quarters that are individually heated and air-conditioned with bathroom facilities.

Each room will comfortably sleep four to eight people. The lodge also features game processing facilities and covered outdoor kennels.

Complete packages include a guided morning duck, goose or sandhill crane hunt and lodging along with home-cooked breakfast and dinner. Afternoon Bay Duck hunting can also be arranged from our lodge.

Our business is based on our commitment to provide our clients with a hunt of a lifetime and our


large percentage of repeat business reflects this fact.

General rules for hunting

The following information addresses some of the more commonly asked questions about hunting and fishing requirements and restrictions. For additional information not included in this guide,

contact your local game warden or phone Texas Parks and Wildlife toll free at 1-800-792-1112.

•IT IS UNLAWFUL TO TAKE OR ATTEMPT TO TAKE OR POSSESS WILDLIFE RESOURCES WITHIN A PROTECTED LENGTH LIMIT, IN GREATER NUMBERS, BY OTHER MEANS, OR AT ANY TIME OR PLACE, OTHER THAN INDICATED WITHIN THIS GUIDE.

•A person who is hunting or trapping must carry on their person and have available for inspection a valid license and any applicable stamps or permits, unless the person is exempt from license, stamp or permit requirements.

•While hunting or trapping, persons 17 years of age or older must carry on their person a valid driver's license or personal identification certificate issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety. Non-residents must carry similar documents issued by the agency in their state or (See Rules, Page 17)



for most of this group are sure-footed and can walk and run on land. Their food is mostly vegetable, and grain-fed mallards or pintails or acorn-fattened wood ducks are highly regarded.


They ride higher in the water than divers, and launch themselves directly upward when rising, whether from land or water.
