Ann will be home for the Christmas holidays to visit with her family and friends. While in basic training, Ann received the following letter from Philip Soto Jr. of Eagle Lake. It was a great help to her and she wanted to share it with all of our readers:

(1962). I have often wondered how different my life would have been had I enlisted.

As I was reading the paper, with your picture on it, I asked myself, "Why would such a beautiful young girl, who could be a model or movie star, join the military?" I can only imagine the reason each one of you decided to enlist.

For those of us back home it probably isn't as important as to the reason you joined as that you did join. Others that have enlisted before you and served their country know what type of training all of you will have to go through. I have no idea what it entails. I assume each of you will deal with it in your own way. To some it will be easy, to others it will be hard.

Each of you went there with a specific reason and/or expectation in mind, possibly undeterred by the tragedy seen on the T.V. Perhaps during your time there you might find yourself asking these questions, "What was I thinking?", "Is my being here going to make a difference?", "Will anybody care if anything happens to me?"

Well let me tell you this, "I care", and it makes a difference to me. Myself and a whole lot of other people acknowledge your commitment. We praise you for sincere effort to take a portion of your life to go through this training in order to be willing and able to serve your country, and at the same time protect our integrity and freedom.

I'm sure I am not the only one that feels that way. We do worry, we do care, and we do pray for your safety. If at the end of an exhausting day of training you ask yourself, "Is it worth it?" Back at home we are very grateful

I did not join any military unit when I was young, although I did take an army test but decided not to go,
