The Emotions, featuring new lead vocalist Suzanne Karr, will provide the Texas dancehall style music for a free street dance on Friday, April 6 from 8 p.m. to midnight during the Seventh Annual Eagle Lake Attwater Prairie Chicken Festival.

The event is scheduled for Thursday, April 5 through Sunday, April 8.

Karr is said to be "tiny like one of those whirlwinds in the west Texas desert...for now stirring up only a small cloud of dust but surely destined to become a tornado."

She was born and raised in Houston and has trained all of her life for the task at hand. For as long as she can remember, she has studied drama and theater, sung in choirs and ensembles, and studied voice and performance.

Karr has fronted some of Houston's best contemporary country bands and spent countless hours in the recording studio.

She is moved by the things and people she sings about. Her songs tell a great deal about her view of the world and about her place in it. Though extremely talented, she is anything, but the stereotypical artist.

Her unassuming style and affecting personality make her a favorite to work with. She has learned how to laugh, and her sense of humor is infectious and ingratiating.

In short, Karr is a rare combination of Texas beauty, unlimited potential and appealing personality. She is a tireless worker, who continues to hone her already remarkable skills.

Other members of the band are Steve Carson on vocals and lead guitar, band manager Calvin Drozd on keyboards, Chad Hudson on lead vocals and acoustic guitar, and James Parr on vocals and acoustic guitar.

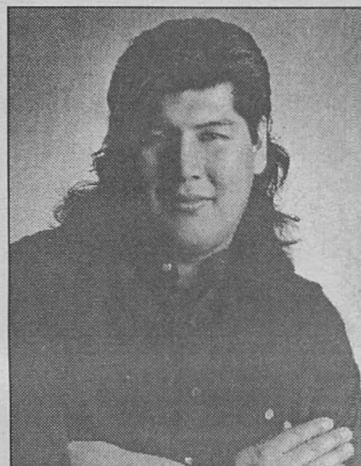
The Emotions also feature Gene Mills on bass guitar and vocals, and Brad Welsh on drums and percussion.

with a Texas sound.

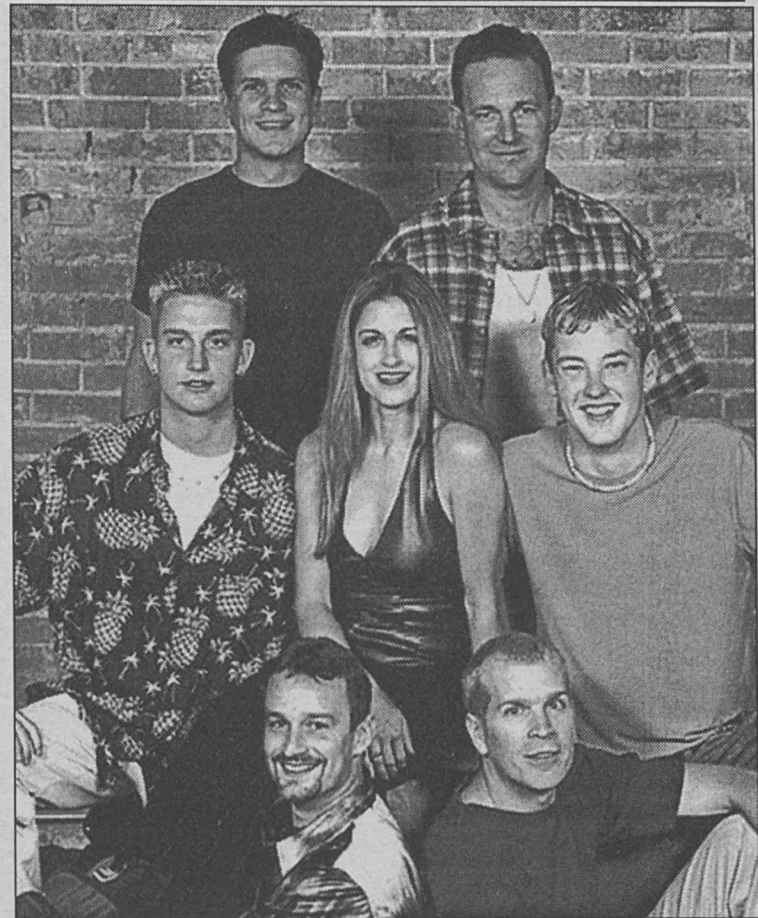
