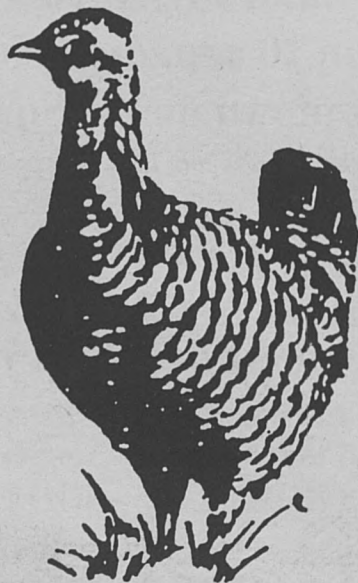

•**BASSMASTER CastingKids' Program** — Downtown Eagle Lake will be the site of this event to be held on Saturday, April 7 from 10 a.m. to noon.
