## What is the Friends of Main Street organization?

This article is to clarify the purpose and outline the goals of the Friends of Main Street.

The Main Street Program has been a part of Eagle Lake since Jan. 2000. There has been much progress, but more is needed and we're still learning as we go.

The Friends of Main Street is the fundraising branch of Main Street Eagle Lake.

Main Street, a self-help revitalization program for building and business owners, is a federal and state program which supports the rejuvenation of deteriorating central business districts across the nation.

Each designated city receives numerous free services, such as architectural assistance, manager and board member training, streetscape planning and community development advice.

Your locally-appointed Main Street Advisory Board gives local incentive grants to business and building owners who wish to make improvements.

This is accomplished with grants

and donations, which is the reason for the Friends of Main Street.

Because the Main Street Program does focus its early energy on the downtown area, the Friends of Main Street would like to reach out to the entire community.

One of the recurring suggestions from many local organizations is more coordination of effort. With this in mind, the Friends of Main Street are trying to put together a master list of every civic, church and social organization in and around Eagle Lake.

The list, when complete, will have a contact person, phone number and address for each organization.

Each organization is a vital component of our city and each has separate ideas and beliefs which contribute to our city as a whole.

Because Eagle Lake is such a small community, it's important that each organization receive the support it needs to carry out its individual goal.

Rather than risk duplication of time and effort, the Friends of Main Street hope that as events are planned, we will be notified so the event may be

posted on a master calendar and you will know if and/or what other events have already been planned for the same time. We will use this list to notify the community of your events

as well as upcoming Main Street events.

## 'Harvesting Ancestors' workshop is Sept. 8

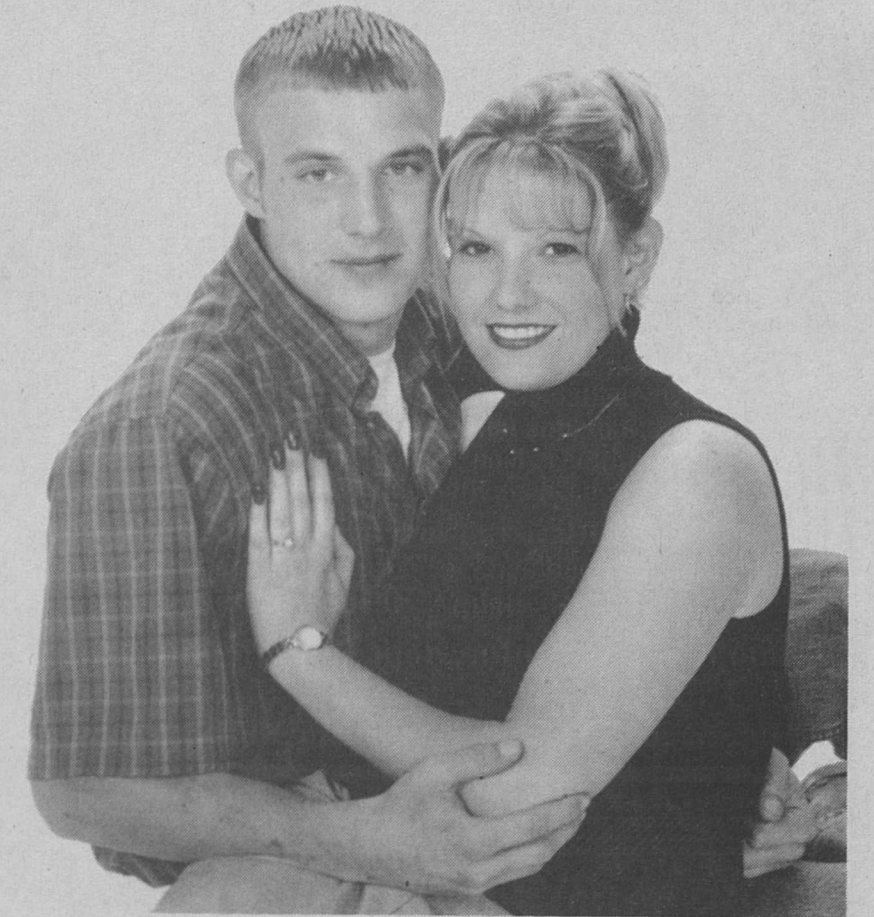

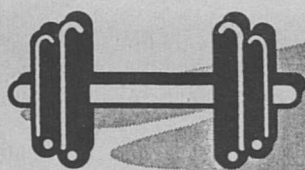

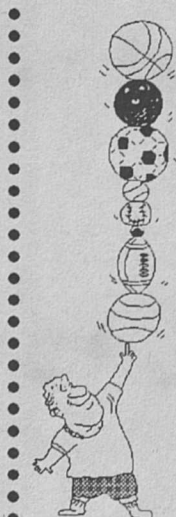
