of a condition known as TMJ SYN-DROME (temporomandibular joint syndrome). Symptoms includes aches and pain in and around the jaw joint (just in front of the ears), muscle spasms, headache, stiff neck, popping or clicking of the jaw upon opening.

Often the cause of these problems is a bad bite, so it is important that you have your bite checked periodically, even if you are not suffering from this syndrome. Similarly, if you or your child have an open bite, either in front or on the side, you should inquire into both its dental correction and how to stop the

Many problems of the jaw are part tongue-thrusting habit that frequently leads to an open bite.

If you notice that you or your child are pressing your tongue against the front teeth when swallowing, you may have a problem and you should check into correcting it if at all possible. Malocclusions resulting from tongue thrusts, when coupled with stress, certainly can trigger a TMJ SYN-
