

Celebrating their new home at the Colorado County Ag Complex, the fair association brought in a record crowd with Chris LeDoux in 2000, followed by Trace Adkins last year. Allan last appeared at the Colorado County Fair in 1997, before he was a widely recognized entertainer, and is expected to draw similar crowds.

Now a top recording artist along with Lyle Lovett and many other non-traditional country singers under contract with MCA Nashville, Allan is dubbed the "Surfin' Cowboy" by fans and friends alike. A native of Orange County, California, Allan's music has been described as hard-core.
