A popular shopping spot at the Colorado County Fair will again be open and many items will be for sale.

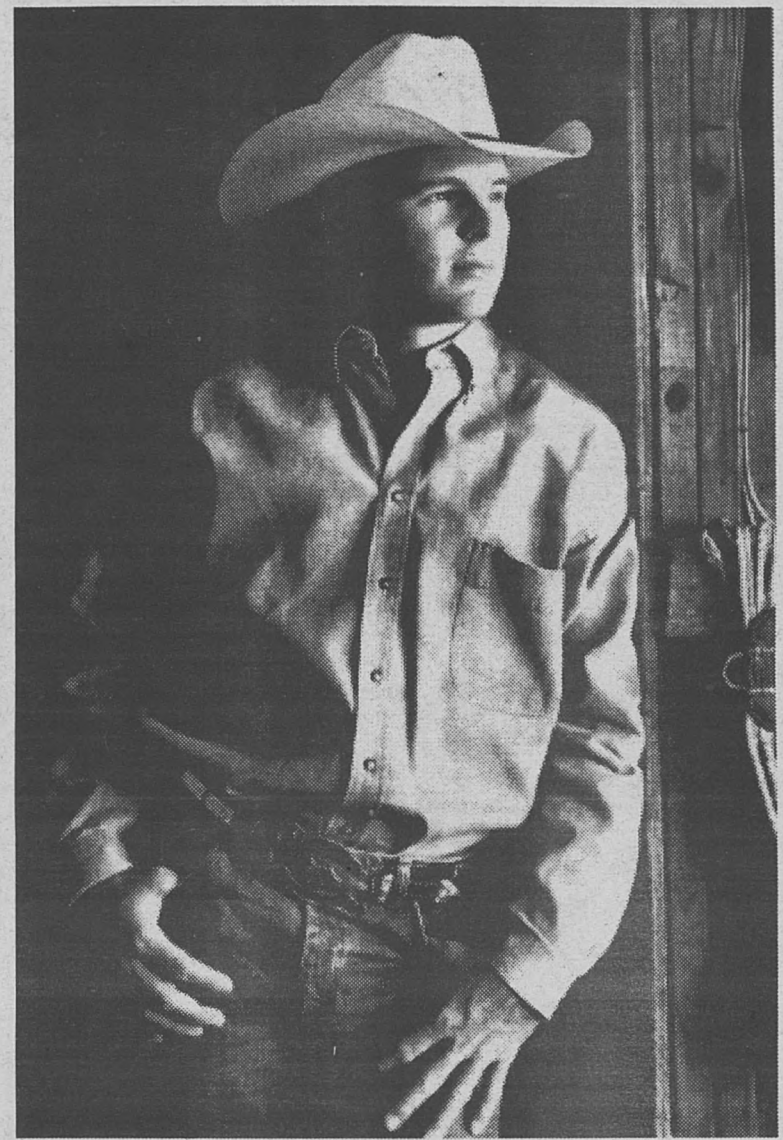
