

LAW ENFORCEMENT

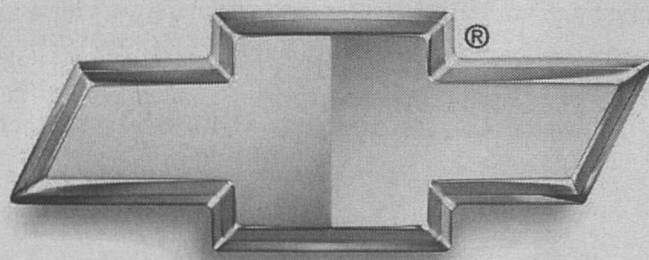
