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(Type 292): \$50

Become a Texas Conservation Passport (TCP) member and receive a vehicle decal/permit so you won't pay entry fees at most state parks for a whole year (valid for one calendar year from the month of purchase). Members get free entry to wildlife management areas, a free tour at state historical parks and a 12% discount on nature tours at select private ranches. The award-winning Texas Conservation Passport Journal is mailed four times a year bringing advance notice of park events. Duplicates for up to two additional vehicles are \$15 each (Type 293).

Social Security Numbers Required by Law: The collection of the Social Security Number is mandated by the Federal Government. TPWD has no option but to comply with Federal Law and collect the numbers from the purchasers of licenses. TPWD cannot force you to provide your social security number; however, under Federal Statute, we cannot sell you a license. Your social security number is required to be collected for the purpose of child support collection enforcement under Federal Statute 42 U.S.C.A. 666 and Texas Family Code, Section 231.302. A child under the age of 17 years is not required to furnish a social security number. If you are buying a license for another person, the law requires that the purchaser provide the social security number of the person who will be holding the license.
