ers' dollars and schools are accountable not only for student learning, but also for achieving these results cost-effectively and efficiently.

The Schools FIRST accountability rating system assigns one of four financial accountability ratings to a school district, the highest being "Superior Achievement," followed by "Above-Standard Achievement," "Standard Achievement" and "Substandard Achievement."

Districts with serious data quality problems may receive the additional rating of "Suspended-Data Quality." Districts that receive the "Substandard Achievement" or "Suspended-Data Quality" ratings under Schools FIRST must file a corrective action plan with the Texas Education Agency.
