local cemeteries. The Post will appreciate a telephone call when family members do have to place flags on overlooked graves.


Thank troops and veterans

With thousands of troops deployed overseas and thousands more readying for deployment, The American Legion has relaunched a free, easy way to thank them for their service on the eve of Veterans Day, Nov. 11.

The electronic cards are also ideal to thank all veterans, of all generations, who have served in the U.S. armed forces. "Veterans and those serving in the military services today need to see that there are friends and family members who are proud of their sacrifices for America," Thomas P. Cadmus, national commander of The American Legion said.

Anyone who has an e-mail account can receive the special cards. Creating the card is quick at The American Legion's website, www.legion.org. "Our troops serving overseas often have access to e-mail and they look forward to the cards that do not take a lot of bandwidth," Cadmus said.

The American Legion site offers e-mail cards representing each military service along with the service song that plays when the card is opened. Each card pro-

vides plenty of space to compose a personal message.

The free service is being offered for the sixth consecutive year. Cards may be sent now through Nov. 12.
