Police Chief Bill Lattimore advised that the Police Department currently has only one vehicle that is operational that is outfitted with a camera. This means that it is the only vehicle that can be used for traffic stops.

Council also authorized the hiring of a new police officer, as officer Justin Alderete has resigned his position.

In other council action:

Council voted to move ahead with the New Town Water System takeover. Council approved a proposal that will be presented to New Town representatives for consideration. The proposal deals mainly with the cost of installing new meters at all the homes to be connected.

The total cost for installing the new meters will be \$295 and council has proposed asking for this payment up-front, or allowing customers to

pay the balance off over a 12-month period. This would amount to \$24.50 per month on the water bill.

Council voted to establish a tree-trimming ordinance. The ordinance allows the city to trim trees that are on private property out of the right of way and charge the owner of the tree for the trimming. The city will give 30 days notice before cutting trees on private property. After this point the city will cut the trees and charge the owner a rate of \$225 per hour for the service. This fee was set by council action following the adoption of the ordinance.

Council voted to allow the hiring of two temporary employees for the crack seal program.

Council authorized a take home vehicle for an on-call public works employee who lives in Garwood.
