The half-cent sales tax rebate for Colorado County was up 11.34 percent for the month, with a payment of \$60,216.

For the year in Colorado County, the payments totaled \$281,191, and increase of 10.11 percent.

In Fayette County, the half-cent sales tax was up 29.43 percent, with a payment of \$75,267.

For the year in Fayette County, the payments totaled \$332,002, an increase of 12.04 percent.

Checks sent to area cities for April with changes from last year were as follows:

Columbus - \$69,523, down 1.51 percent; for the year, \$318,710, up 4.02 percent.

Weimar - \$18,142, up 6.85 percent; for the year, \$85,065, up 8.08 percent.

Schulenburg - \$40,104, up 22.66 percent; for the year, \$165,764, up 17.49 percent.

La Grange - \$92,151, up 24.43 percent; for the year, \$410,104, up 13.26 percent.

Flatonia - \$11,131, up 16.23 percent; for the year, \$62,599, up 31.92 percent.

Hallettsville - \$59,235, up 9.05 percent; for the year, \$265,656, up 9.87 percent.
