Enjoy A Delicious Egg Salad Today

The Easter season is one that's become synonymous with eggs. Be it the annual Easter egg hunt out in the yard or just the time you might spend painting your eggs with the kids, those with children know that eggs play a big role when it comes to celebrating this holiday. But while those eggs are most often filled with chocolate, others looking for the more traditional yolk-filled egg can look to Egg Salad Week (April 17 to 23) as a time to celebrate their love of eggs.

With egg-filled events right around the corner, here's a recipe for "Warm Egg Salad with Tomatoes and Vinaigrette," courtesy of Anne Willan who founded her own school, Ecole de Cuisine La Varenne, in Paris 25 years ago and also authored "The Good Cook" (Stewart, Tabori & Chang).
Warm Egg Salad with Tomatoes and Vinaigrette
Serves 4 as a first course

- 6 eggs
- 3 large tomatoes
- 1/4 cup olive oil, more for drizzling salt and pepper to taste
- 4 teaspoons red wine vinegar
- 1 garlic clove, finely chopped
- 3 tablespoons, dry bread crumbs
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh parsley

Put the eggs in a saucepan and cover generously with water. Bring to a boil and then simmer them until hard-boiled, 10 to 12 minutes. Plunge the eggs in cold water to cool them and stop the cooking. Peel them under cold running water, dry them, and halve them lengthwise.

Meanwhile, cut each tomato crosswise in four thick slices, discarding the ends. Set three tomato slices on four serving plates, drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Set them aside.
Stir together the oil, vinegar, pepper and a large pinch of salt in a frying pan and heat it. Add the egg halves, cut side down, and cook over low heat until the vinegar has evaporated, 3 to 5 minutes. Turn the eggs once or twice during cooking. With a slotted spoon, transfer the eggs to the serving plates, putting an egg half, cut side up, on top of each tomato slice.

Add the garlic to the frying pan and sauté over low heat until soft and fragrant, about 1 minute. Stir in the bread crumbs and cook them until golden brown, stirring constantly, 3 to 4 minutes. Spoon the mixture over the eggs and sprinkle with parsley.
