

## Andrew Smith To Deliver Blinn College Address

Andrew Smith of Hempstead, a 2006 candidate for graduation at Blinn College, will deliver the main address for commencement on May 11 in Spencer Stadium on the Brenham campus.

Smith, a 2004 distinguished graduate of Brenham Christian Academy and the son of Rooster and Carolyn Smith of Hempstead, is currently the president of the Brenham campus

Beta Alpha chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, the international academic honor society for two-year colleges.

He also serves a chaplain of the campus Student Government Association and president of the Blinn College Medical Education Development Society.

Smith is a charter member of the Blinn Lions Club and is a member of the Mu Alpha Theta national math-

ematics honor society.

He is employed part-time at Brenham Clinic where he was named Employee of the Year for 2005.

A President's Scholar at Blinn, he has been nominated to the USA Today All-Texas and All-USA academic teams.

Smith plans to attend either Texas A&M University or Rice University, majoring in pre-medicine or biological sciences.

Other graduates participating in the program will be Jacob Bunch of Pearland, president of the Blinn Lions, who will deliver the invocation; Hector Weir of Bryan, vice-president of the Bryan campus Alpha Phi Lambda chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, who will lead the pledge to the American flag; David Tofel of La Grange, Bryan campus Student Government Association treasurer, who will introduce Smith; and Misty Touchet of La Grange, a graduate from the Schulenburg campus, who will deliver the benediction.

Graduates from the college's four campuses -- Brenham, Bryan, Schulenburg and Sealy -- will participate in the commencement, which begins at 8 p.m. In the event of inclement weather, the ceremonies will be moved to the Brenham High School auditorium.
