

The impact knocked the rear axle of the truck about 25 yards down the track. The train stopped about a quarter mile down the tracks.

The train did not derail, but suffered damage to the front of the engine.

The train had two locomotives, a dining car, lounge, two day coaches and two sleeping coaches.

The accident was investigated by DPS Trooper Kent Tipton.

Tipton said a freight train parked on a side track near the location reduced visibility at the crossing.



How will the Bond improve my child's educational experience?

Junior High and High School students will have access to programs, facilities and other benefits not otherwise available to them:

- A High honors or PreAP program implemented at the Junior High level. With PreAP courses available earlier, students will have an opportunity and the time to take courses for college credit their senior year in High School.
- More elective courses available for Junior High students to choose from rather than having one or two mandatory elective courses forced on them.
- The ability to offer Special Needs classes that are age appropriate. Currently there is as much as a 7 year age difference in one class.
- Allows for a consolidation of teachers. It is now necessary

to hire 3 teachers to teach Pre-algebra or IPC (Introduction to Physics and Chemistry) to approximately 30 children who are spread out over 3 different campuses. If the school district can only locate and hire one or two teachers, pre-algebra and/or IPC will be dropped on all campuses.

- The new High School will have 4 new science labs with up-to-date equipment needed for students preparing to go to college.
- Computer labs and classrooms on all campuses will have up-to-date technology, such as new computers and new operating systems.
- The Career and Technology Center will be remodeled to improve current facilities to better prepare students for a vocational/trade college or career.
- Junior High students will have their own gymnasium for athletics and physical education.
- A new stage meeting the size requirements for UIL performance specifications.
- A new Band Hall for grades 6th-12th with good acoustics.
