State Wheat Production Down 64 Percent

The 2006 Texas winter wheat crop is forecast at 35.0 million bushels, down 64 percent from last year, and 68 percent from 2004, but up eight percent from the June forecast.

According to a July 1 survey conducted by the Texas Field Office, statewide yield is expected to average 25 bushels per acre, down seven bushels from last year and the same as the June forecast.

Harvested acreage, at 1.4 million acres, is down 53 percent from 2005, but up eight percent from June 1.

Production on the Northern High Plains is forecast at 13 million bushels, down 77 percent from last year.

Winter wheat production on the Low Plains is forecast at 7.0 million bushels, down 65 percent from last year.

Blacklands' production is estimated at 9.6 million bushels, up 55 percent from last year.

Production on the Edwards Plateau is forecast at 850 thousand bushels, down 81 percent from the 2005 crop.

United States winter wheat production for 2006 is forecast at 1.28 billion bushels, up one percent from last month but down 15 percent from 2005.

Yield is expected to average 41.1 bushels per acre, up 0.6 bushel from last month but down 3.3 bushels from last year.

Acreage to be harvested for grain is expected to total 31.1 million acres, down eight percent from a year ago, and unchanged from last month.

20 percent to the city on fees collected. This fee will come out of the fine amount collected.

The city currently has about \$180,000 in outstanding court fines that the firm will attempt to collect.

Council said that many of the fines are difficult to collect because they are from people from out of town that were passing through.

City Manager Ron Holland said that Colorado County uses this same firm to collect their outstanding fines.

He advised that County Judge Al Jamison said these collections have essentially become another revenue source for the county and that he recommended doing it.

In other council action:
-Council approved on a two to one vote to make a request for a Texas Department of Transportation Grant to build new hangars at the airport. The new hangars will be large enough to accommodate business class aircraft, which there has been a demand for.

The grant will provide \$113,000 for construction while the city will have to provide a match of \$27,000. Holland advised that the city has approval for a loan to pay the match amount and that the revenues for the hangar rentals are expected to exceed the amount of the loan payment.

"The budget is not looking good, I recommend tabling this and picking it up after we have an idea what the budget will look like," said Mayor Mike Morales. "We have a lot of issues to look at," he added.

After discussion Councilman Chriss Schuirring made a motion, seconded by Councilman John Young, to proceed with project.

Young and Schuirring voted for the motion, with Councilman Dave Curry against and Councilwoman Jane Meldahl abstained from the vote.

-Council voted to authorize Morales and Holland to make a decision regarding a garbage truck that needs a new engine. The primary garbage truck recently broke down and a new engine is needed. There were some questions regarding a warranty on the engine to be put in and council gave Morales and Holland permission to proceed after that information was obtained. Holland advised on Monday that the engine will be a rebuilt one and will have a one-year warranty. It will cost around \$18,000 for the repairs.

-Council tabled action an ordinance to install a stop sign on Melody Lane at Burns Street. Council will act on an ordinance to make the intersection a three-way stop at their next regular meeting.

-Council heard from Veronica Gonzales who addressed council to complain about bees being kept by a neighbor. She advised that the bees seemed to be aggressive and the bees had stung that she and her boyfriend and she is worried about her children getting stung. She asked if there was anything that could be done about the bees.

Council will discuss the issue at the next meeting.
