down pass, making the score 21-7 after Samaniego converted the extra point attempt.

Sealy took possession on their own 33 following the kickoff and quickly drove to the Rice 33, with Rodgers gaining 27 yards on three carries.

Facing third and nine from the Rice 32, Reichardt mishandled the snap in the shotgun, leading to a thirteen yard loss.

Rice took over on their own 38 following a failed fourth down conversion attempt by Sealy.

The Raiders advanced the ball with the aid of several nice runs by Foster and overcame a second and one holding call to gain a first down before Cook found Pratt for a 21 yard touchdown reception.

The touchdown made the score 28-7 following Samaniego's kick on the extra point.

On the ensuing kickoff Rice executed a near perfect outside kick, with Samaniego's low ball hopping over a Sealy player before skittering into the hands of Lobpries at the Sealy 36 yard line.

Rice promptly drove for a touchdown, with Brian Williams taking the ball into the end zone from three yards out to make the score 35-7 with 4:34 remaining in the third quarter, following Samaniego's extra point kick.

However, Sealy responded quickly after taking possession at their own 47 yard line on the ensuing kickoff.

A combination of runs from Rodgers and Browne, in again at quarter back, led to a quick touchdown from running back Freddie Harrison and a converted

extra point.

The score stood at 35-14 with 1:36 left in the third quarter.

Rice went three and out on the following drive, with quarter back Cook booming an impressive 50 yard punt.

Sealy struck quickly on the following drive.

After a series of impressive runs from Reichardt and Rodgers, wide receiver Landon Kehde pulled in a 32 yard catch for a touchdown that made the score 35-21.

The Tigers then repaid Rice for their earlier trickery, executing a successful outside kick of their own.

After Sealy took possession at the Rice 37 yard line they drove all the way to the 14 and Rice looked in danger of losing the momentum until linebacker Esquivel recovered a Rodgers fumble near the Rice goal line.

Esquivel returned the fumble 85 yards for a touchdown, which was called back on a clipping penalty, giving Rice possession at the Sealy 47 yard line.

Rice quickly drove for a touchdown and despite having a touchdown pass called back, scored on a 33 yard Cook touchdown pass to Pratt that put the game beyond doubt.

After a failed two point conversion attempt the score stood at 41-21.

The remainder of the game played out quickly, with Sealy scoring a consolation touchdown through running back Harrison to make the final score 41-28.


