## Army General To Speak At WCJC

Major General John H. Bailey, II remembers getting his boot heels shot off as an Army aviator during the Vietnam War. More vivid though is the memory of his friend, Lieutenant Johnson, who along with 35 soldiers, died in a Chinook helicopter accident on the way to Vongtau, the Army's designated safe center for rest and relaxation.

"I remember this most because I could have been there," said Bailey, who instead remained behind to write a letter to his wife. "I also remember it because Johnson was a great guy and a great soldier, and he and 35 young soldiers went down that day."

This highly-decorated general will reflect on similar sacrifices made by American men and women who answer the call to serve their country as he headlines the Fall 2006 Wharton County Junior College (WCJC) President's Lecture Series on Thursday, Oct. 19. Bailey's address, entitled "From Boston to Baghdad," will also examine the changes in American military culture beginning with the American Revolution.

The lecture begins at 7:30 p.m. in the WCJC Horton Foote Theatre in the Duson-Hansen Fine Arts Building. It is free and open to the public and includes a tribute to U.S. military personnel. The WCJC Band and the WCJC Choir will contribute patriotic music, while the Wharton High School Air Force Junior ROTC Color Guard will present the colors and lead the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. Following Bailey's presentation and Q&A session, a military roll call will be held. Attendees are encouraged to wear their military uniforms and/or medals.

During his first tour of duty in Vietnam, Bailey was a paratrooper with the 101st Airborne Division. He went on to become a fixed wing aviator accumulating 1265 combat hours with the First Aviation Brigade. Among his 17 awards and honors are the Soldiers Medal for heroism, the Bronze Star with oak leaf cluster for Exceptional Meritorious Achievement while participating in aerial flight, the Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf cluster and two "V" devices for heroism, and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry for Bravery.

Upon his return to Texas, Bailey began a distinguished career in military science education. In 1984 he joined Clear Creek Independent School District in southeast Houston as director of military science. He now oversees a Junior ROTC program that includes 926 cadets and 14 instructors at four high schools and seven intermediate campuses.

One of Bailey's many legacies is his founding of the Leadership Development Corps for cadets in grades 6-8 at Clear Creek ISD. This program, which has expanded to schools in Houston ISD, Dallas and Oklahoma, teaches "leadership development, teamwork and a positive can-do attitude," according to Bailey.

A Clear Creek ISD spokesman said Bailey "has done amazing things with our students." She added, "He is truly an American hero and an inspiration to many."

In 1991, Bailey became the first African-American to attain the rank of brigadier general in the Texas State Guard, an honor bestowed upon him by Governor
