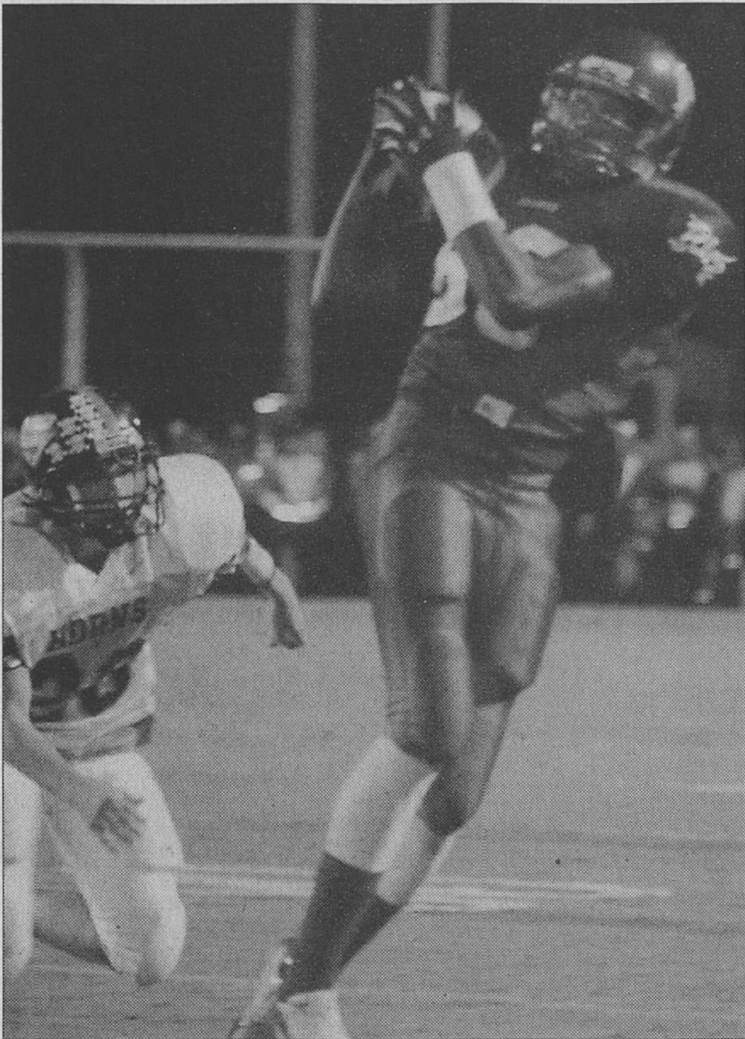


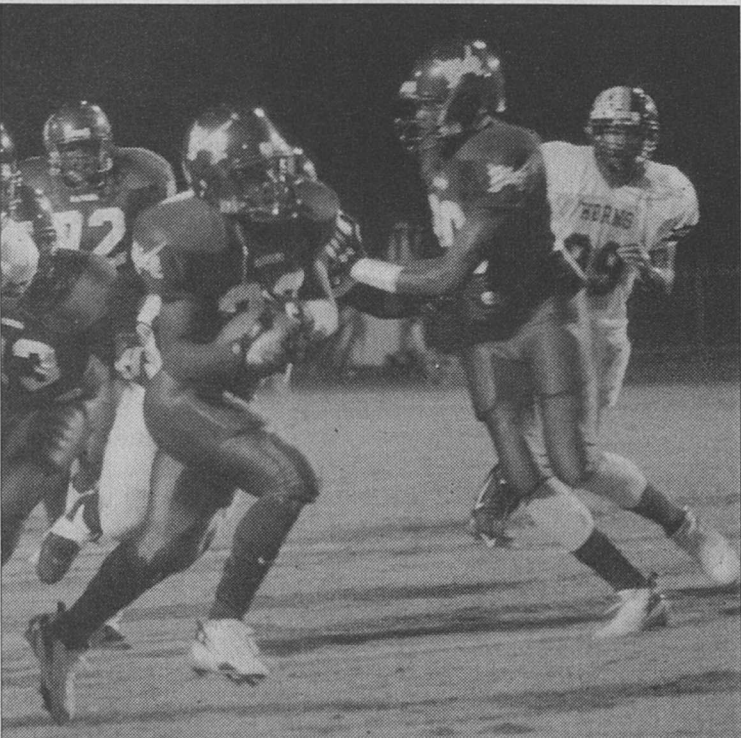

Raiders Lose Tough Game Against Schulenburg

loss on the next play, bringing up third-and-goal from the eight.

Besetzny took the next snap and rolled to his left and found his big man Moore for an eight-yard pitch-and-catch touchdown.

Carlos Lara made the extra point for a 7-0 Shorthorn lead with 6:55 left in the opening quarter.

The Raiders started their first possession at the 27-yard line following the Schulenburg kickoff.

After two running plays for no gain and a loss, Cook threw complete to Brian Williams for a 15-yard gain and a first down at the 39.

Foster then carried the ball for 9 yards and after an incomplete pass Cook ran the ball on a quarterback keeper for seven yards and another Raider first down to the Schulenburg 46.

Foster carried on the next play for three yards followed by Lobpries with a five-yard rush.

Cook kept the ball on third down for four yards and a Raider first down at the 34.

After two ineffective running

plays, Cook threw incomplete on third down bringing up fourth-and-nine.

The Raiders were poised to roll the dice and go for the first down, but a false start penalty forced the Raiders to punt.

The punt from Cook bounced into the endzone for a touch-back.

Schulenburg ran the ball for three straight times for a first down to the 32.

Besetzny then threw complete to Lara for an 18-yard gain to the 50.

After a short Houston carry and a holding penalty, Besetzny found Shane Mayberry for a 19-yard gain to the 40.

Besetzny then kept the ball for a six-yard gain to the 35 for a first down.

After a short gain on first down, Besetzny carried the ball for ten yards, but a Raider late hit added 15 yards to the end of the play, giving Schulenburg a first down at the 12.

A false start pushed them

back, but Houston carried the ball for four yards to the 13 on the next play.

On second down, Besetzny found Moore open again for a 13-yard touchdown pass.

Lara hit the extra point for a 14-0 Schulenburg lead with 7:02 left in the half.

Rice started their next possession at the 27-yard line, but on the second play a miscue on a handoff led to a fumble recovery by Schulenburg at the Raider 24.

Schulenburg drove down to the ten-yard line, but on second down, Lobpries came up with a huge nine-yard sack, bringing up third and 19.

An incompletion forced Schulenburg to try a field goal.

Lara's 36-yard attempt sailed through the uprights for a 17-0 lead with 4:31 left in the half.

Rice got the ball on the 36-yard line to start their next drive and Cook hit Marques Toliver for an eight-yard gain to the 36.

A false start pushed Rice back to the 31 and then Cook completed

a short pass to Williams for a two-yard gain.

On fourth-and-seven the Raiders chose to again go for a first down, and Schulenburg was called for offside, making it fourth-and-two.

The Raiders handed off to Foster who burst through the line and rambled 61 yards to put the Raiders on the board. Rice tried a fake extra point, but it failed, making the score 17-6 in favor of Schulenburg with 1:35 left on the clock.

Halftime came with the same tally lit-up on the scoreboard.

Schulenburg got the ball to start the second half, and set-up shop on the 35.

The Raider defense had a nice series.

Schulenburg ran the ball and gained a first down at the 47.

After a short gain, and a false start penalty, Besetzny threw incomplete on second down.

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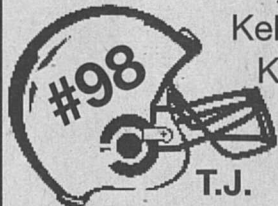
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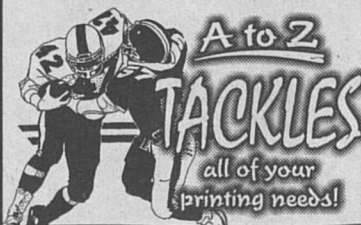
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
