Raiders Sack Indians For 45-20 Win

"We always try to get an early edge, I feel like it is a confidence builder for us," said Dumont.

Ganado started their next possession at the 20-yard line.

They pushed the ball to the 33 with a Raider penalty and a seven-yard carry.

A short gain followed by a false start penalty made it second-and-14.

Marcus Hernandez stopped a Ganado rush attempt for one-yard bringing-up third-and-long.

Jasmine Hemphill got through the line and batted down a pass attempt on third down and forced Ganado to punt again.

Williams fielded the punt and returned it to 42 yards to the Ganado 22.

On first down, Cook threw complete to Williams for 14 yards to the 8.

Foster then carried the ball for two yards to the 6.

On second-and-goal Cook found Darkeith Pratt open for another Raider touchdown.

The extra point was no good, making the score 13-0 with 5:46 left in the first quarter.

Ganado took over at the 35 for their next possession.

On first down, Suarez, Chris Dorsey and Botard teamed up to stop a Ganado rush attempt behind the line for a four-yard loss.

An incomplete pass on the next play brought up another third-and-long, but Ganado came through with a 28-yard pass play for the first down at the Raider 40.

They ran the ball on the next three plays for a first down at the 27.

Two more carries for five and three yards brought up a third-and two for Ganado.

Suarez came up with a big play and tackled a rusher for only one yard, making it fourth down and one.

Ganado opted to go a first down, but the Raider line stacked-up and stopped a rush attempt for no gain, giving the Raider offense the ball at the 18.

A 14-yard carry from Ross

Lobpries brought the ball out to the 31.

After a short loss, Cook carried for five yards, but the Raiders faced a third-and-seven.

Cook threw complete to Williams for a 19-yard pick-up and the first down.

The drive fizzled out after an incomplete pass followed by a short loss and another incomplete pass.

The Raiders were forced to punt on fourth-and-thirteen.

Cook's punt was downed at the 18-yard line.

Ganado ran the ball for two, then four yards before completing a pass for 12 yards and a first down at the 36.

They ran the ball for another five, but Williams intercepted a pass attempt on the next play. An illegal block occurred during the return and the Raiders got the ball at the 46.

The Raiders again needed only one play to score a touchdown.

Rice spread out the defense by shifting three receivers wide right, and one receiver wide left.

This left the middle of the field wide-open for Clayton Bowen coming out of the slot. Cook hit him about 15 yards down field with a perfect pass and Bowen took it the rest of the way for a 54-yard touchdown.

"We wanted to get Bowen the ball, he has been with the program and worked hard for four years," said Dumont about the play.

Stern made the extra point for a 20-0 Raider lead with 6:47 left in the half.

Ganado took over on the 20 for their next possession.

After an incomplete pass and a play for no-gain, Ganado picked up five yards from a Raider penalty and then rushed for four yards bringing-up fourth-and-one.

Ganado again decided to go for it and their running back burst through the line and took it 71 yards for Ganado's first score.

The extra point was good, and with 5:09 left in the half, the score was 20-7 in favor of the Raiders.

Foster got the ball on first down from the 21 and rushed for about 44 yards. An illegal block negated about half of the run, but Rice had a first down at the 32.

Foster carried again, this time for three yards.

A run attempt on the next play was stopped for a four-yard loss and Rice was forced to punt after

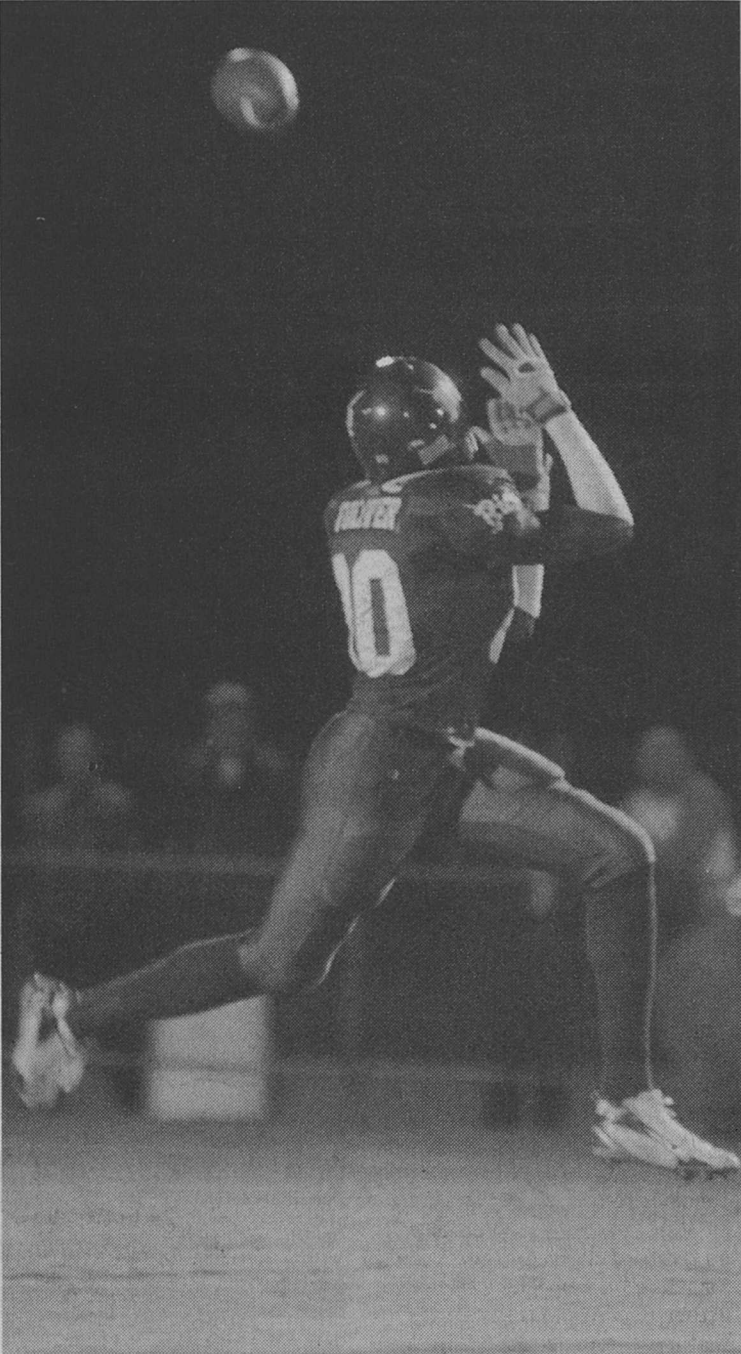
an incomplete pass.

Ganado took over at their-own 48 and rushed for three yards on first down.

On second down, Hemphill and Danklefs stopped a rush attempt for a two-yard loss.

An incomplete pass forced Ganado to punt.
