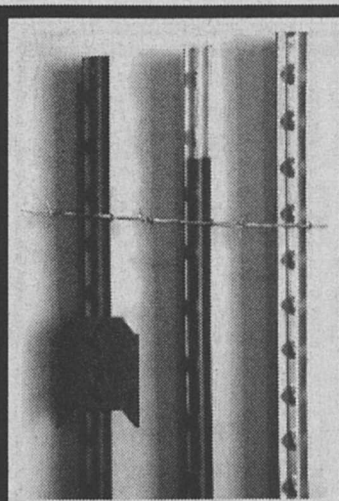

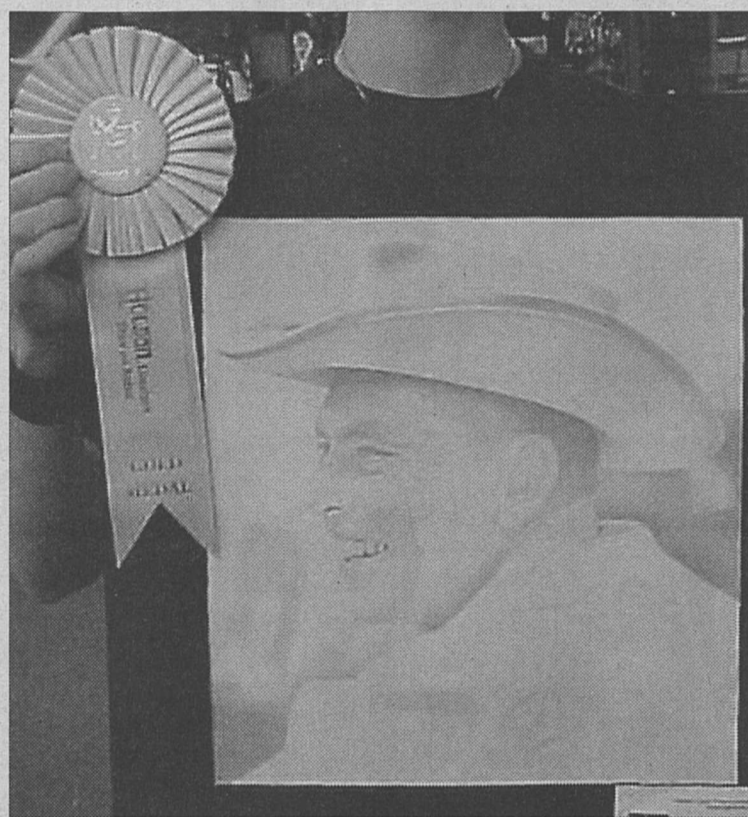

More than 50 pieces of art work will be selected for auction and these winners will receive scholarship money for college.

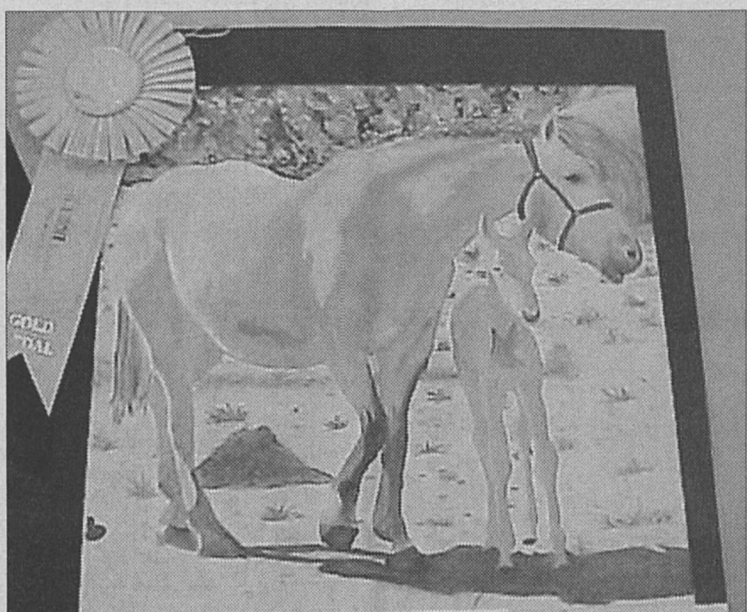
Congratulations go out to all the winners in the district and for all students who participated in the district show and the students appreciated the community attending the open house to view the great artist in the Rice CISD.

Treatment For Seasonal Affective Disorder

Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD) is a type of mild to moderate depression that often begins in North America in the Fall and lasts until the Spring. This condition tends to be more common in places further away from the equator. Although this condition is not severe, persons with this condition may still experience significant impairment in their daily lives. Seasonal Affective Disorder is characterized by feelings of sluggishness, decreased motivation and decreased productivity occurring during the winter months. Persons with this condition also may feel that they are not able to get enough sleep and may gain weight during the winter months. The cause of SAD is not known, however it is thought that the shortened amount of daylight may be related to a change in the levels of melatonin secreted by the body, as well as a change in natural serotonin activity. It is not known why certain persons are more likely to be affected by this condition than others.

The standard treatment for Seasonal Affective Disorder is therapeutic light. Antidepressants are also helpful in the treatment of SAD. Wellbutrin XL (bupropion hydrochloride extended-release tablets) received approval by the FDA in 2006 for the treatment of recurrent major depressive episodes with the SAD pattern.
