7th grade ended the season with a 10-6 record and the 8th graded ended the season with a 12-4 record! Both groups had a great season!!

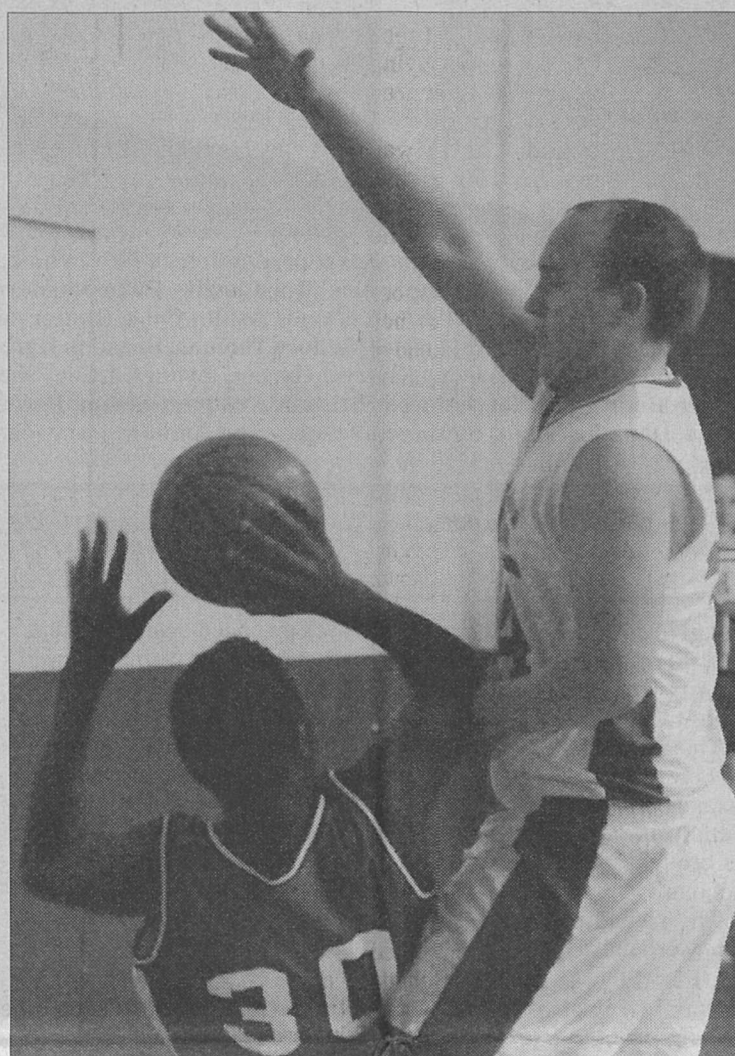
