Request for Proposals- Workforce Transportation Projects

The Texas Department of Transportation announces a Request for Proposals (RFP) for workforce transportation projects. The project will be funded through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) Program and will be administered by TxDOT.

The purpose of the funding is for public transportation projects for access to jobs and reverse commute purposes. Eligible applicants include local governmental authorities, private nonprofit organizations, operators of public transportation services and private for-profit operators of public transportation services.

TX DOT's responsibility will be to educate the community - encourage non-traditional partnerships - work with the regional planning lead agencies, local employers and the workforce boards.

A Statewide Pre-Proposal Video Teleconference will be held at the TxDOT District Office on February 26, 2007 at the Yoakum TXDOT District Office located at 403 Huck Street from 1:30 - 4:30 PM CST. Please Notify the TxDOT district office, three days prior to the event, if you plan to attend.

TX DOT's request for proposals for JARC projects coming from small urbanized and non-urbanized areas is now available on the Public Transportation Division's home web page at http://www.txdot.gov/services/public_transportation/default.htm. A link to the RFP and other helpful information is found in the second paragraph.

Project applications are due in Austin on May 4, 2007.
