The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Art School Art Awards was held Saturday March 3 at Reliant Center. The Rodeo Art

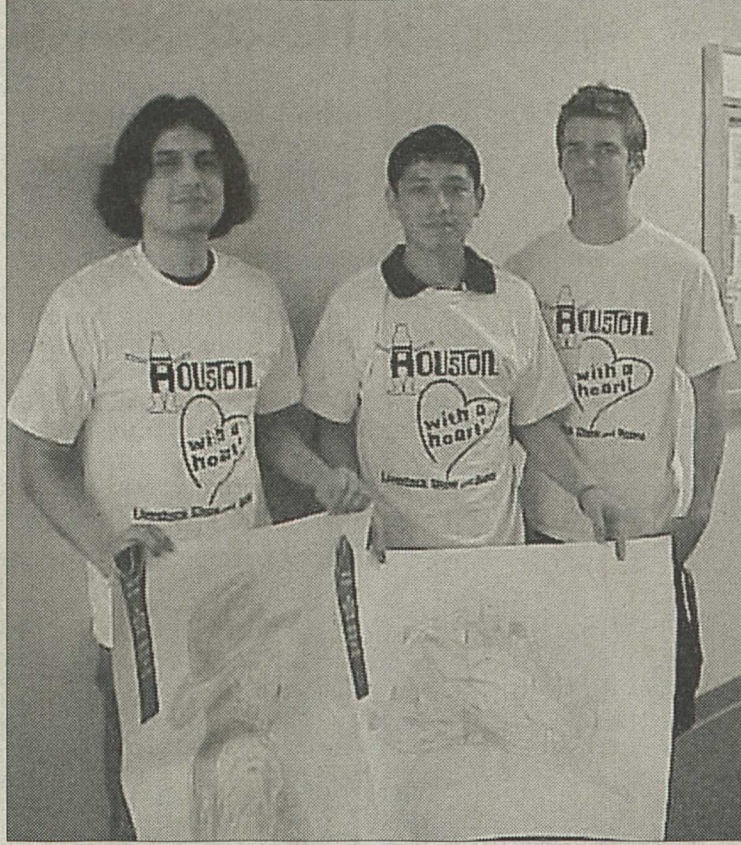
winners from Rice CISD attending the awards ceremony received their trophies and medal during the presentation.

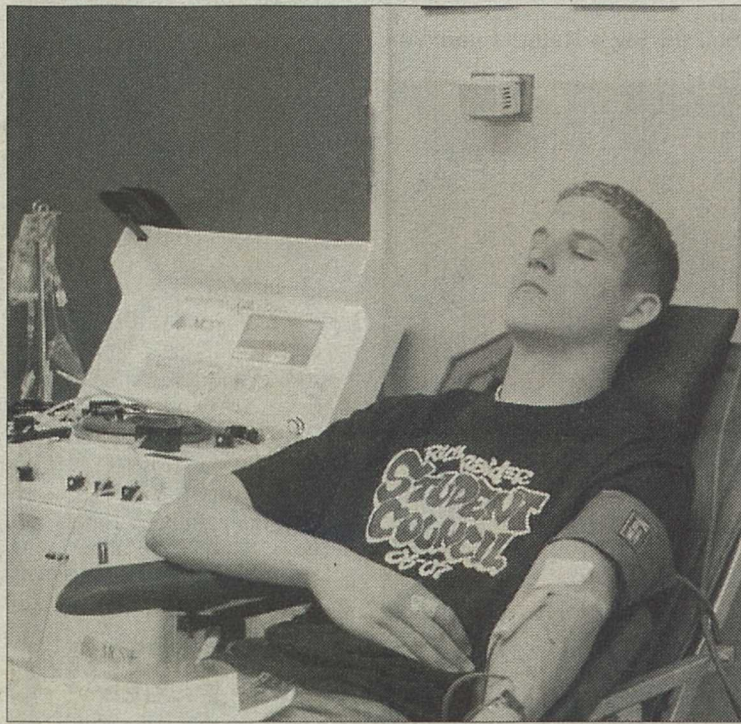
