## Cheesecake Cupcakes Make A Great Treat

### CHEESECAKE CUPCAKES (Makes 12)

- 1 pound cream cheese, softened
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 12 vanilla wafer cookies (such as Nilla Wafers®)

Fruit topping of your choice  
Preheat oven to 350 F. Line regular-sized muffin tins with foil or paper cupcake liners. Place a wafer cookie in the bottom of each liner.

In a bowl, beat cream cheese, eggs, sugar and vanilla until creamy.

Pour mix on top of cookies, filling each cupcake 3/4 full. Bake cupcakes at 350 F for 15 minutes.

Remove from oven and let cool individually on a wire rack.

Top with fruit topping and refrigerate before serving. Enjoy.
