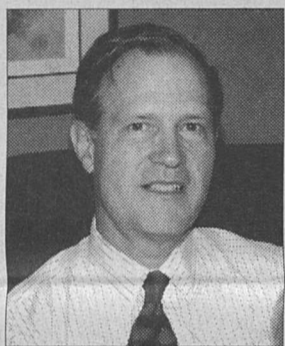

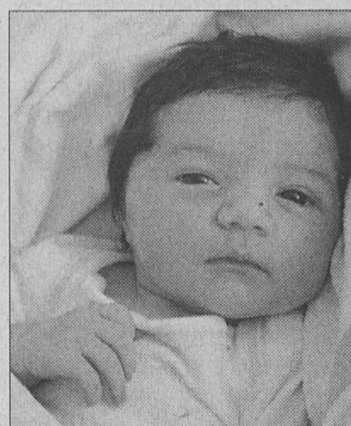


Cassandra Shea Salas

Sophia Rose Cantu

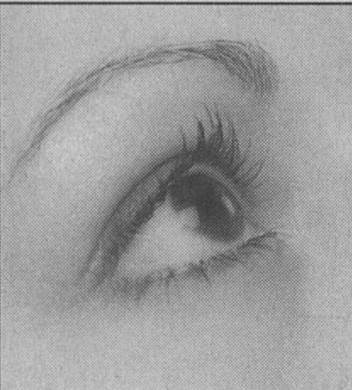
