## Announcement of New Freedom Transportation Projects for Services Targeted to Individuals with Disabilities Public Meeting

The Texas Department of Transportation (department) announces a Request for Proposal (RFP) for transportation projects for services targeted to individuals with disabilities. New Freedom program funds are available for capital and operating expenses that support new public transportation services beyond those required by the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) and new public transportation alternatives beyond those required by the ADA designed to assist individuals with disabilities with accessing transportation services, including transportation to and from jobs and employment support services. Both new public transportation services and new public transportation alternatives are required to go beyond the requirements of the ADA and must (1) be targeted toward individuals with disabilities; and (2) meet the intent of the program by removing barriers to transportation and assisting individuals with disabilities with transportation, including transportation to and from jobs and employment services.

The project will be funded through the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) New Freedom Program (NF), 42 U.S.C. §5317, and will be administered by the TxDOT in compliance with departments rules, published at 43 Texas Administrative Code §31.18. The RFP is available in electronic and printed format from the department.
