originally sought an eight-year prison term. Janak's attorney, Houston Munson, had asked for probation.

The range of punishment for manslaughter is two to 20 years.

As part of the probation, Janak will be required to perform 240 hours of community service.

He is also required to prepare and present a program for high school age persons concerning "alcohol related offenses and the effects and consequences of such crimes."

Koehn said that Rubio and Nino testified at the hearing before Beck as did Janak, a Department of Public Safety Trooper who investigated the accident, and an accident reconstruction specialist hired by the defense.

Koehn said the trooper, Richard Krenek, estimated that the Suburban was traveling at about 88 miles per hour when it ran off the road and overturned.

The posted speed limit was 60 miles an hour.

Koehn said the defense expert testified he estimated the speed at about 77 miles an hour.

Koehn said there was also testimony that if the occupants had been wearing seat belts the injuries would likely have been less severe.

Koehn said that Nino testified that he remembered the vehicle swaying before it went out of control and overturned.

Neither Rubio or Janak said they could remember the accident.

Koehn said there was evi-

dence that a blood sample taken from Janak shortly after the accident had a blood alcohol level of .15 grams per milliliter, with the legal level of in-toxication is .08 grams per milliliter.

Although he had asked for a prison term, Koehn said: "I'm not going to quarrel with the judge's decision."

He noted that Janak had no prior DWI or criminal convictions.

"This is an unfortunate situation. It illustrates how quickly lives can be snuffed out and how lives can be affected forever," he said.

"Hopefully, other kids will take note of the devastation that can occur," he said.

One of the terms of the probation is that Janak cannot possess or consume any alcoholic beverages.

As part of the sentence, Janak was granted deferred adjudication, which means if he completes the term of probation, the case will not appear on his record.

Koehn said he agreed to reduction of charge from intoxication manslaughter to manslaughter after the judge indicated he was inclined to grant deferred adjudication.

Deferred adjudication could not have been granted for intoxication manslaughter.

Ryba's mother, Barbara Ryba, also testified at the hearing.

Koehn said she said that she felt Janak needed to be held responsible, but said she also hoped that some good could come out of the tragedy.
