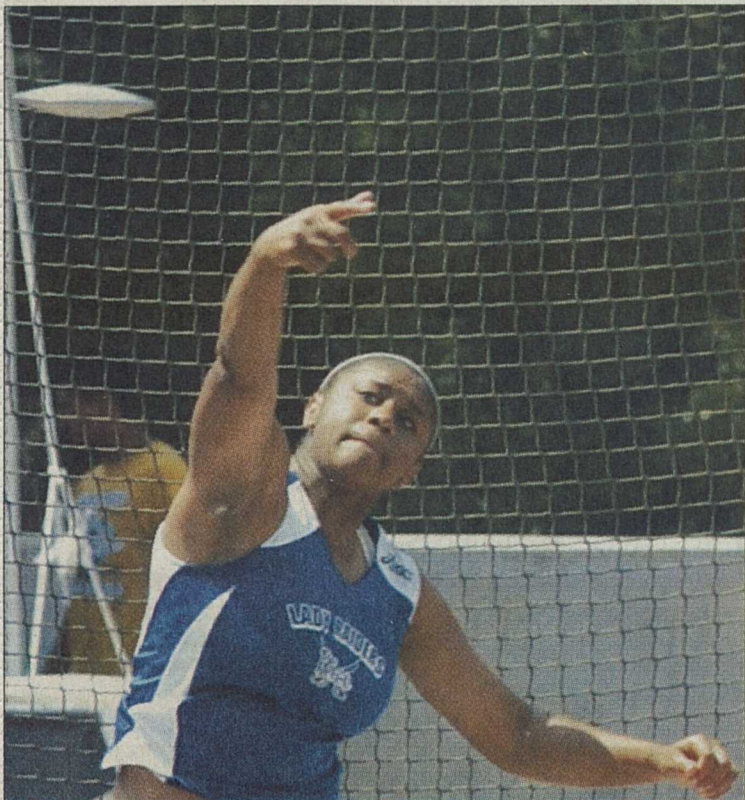




Josh Williams competed in the State Track meet on May 12. He finished in sixth place with a vault of 13'6".
