The Mustangs are grateful to those from Eagle Lake and the surrounding areas who chose to make the trip to Columbus to watch a heck of a game.

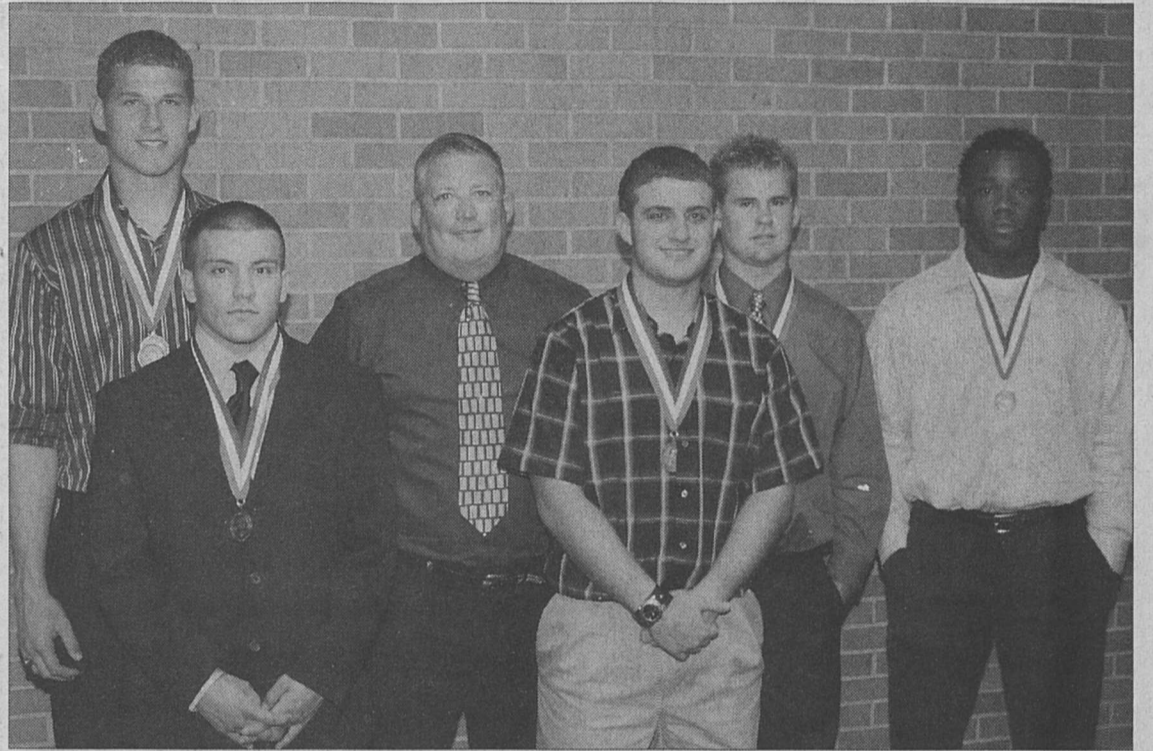
I thought it was going to be a whole different ballgame. When the first inning ended 0-0, I was sure the Heat would run away with it after that. But, my girls turned it up and got the win.
