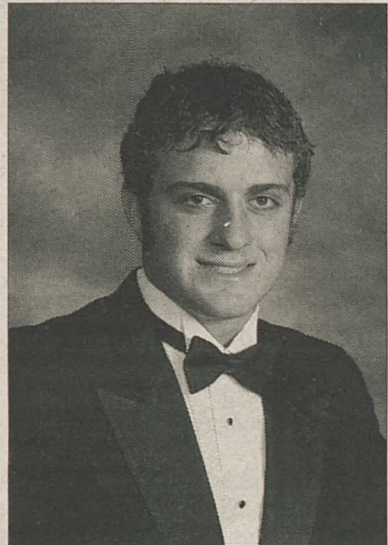

After graduation he plans to attend the University of Texas in Austin and receive a Bachelors Degree in Fine Arts.

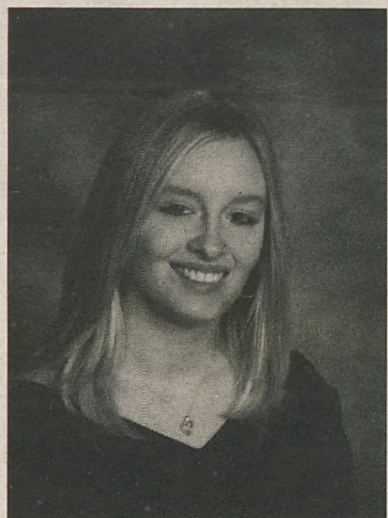


**Travis James Danklefs
