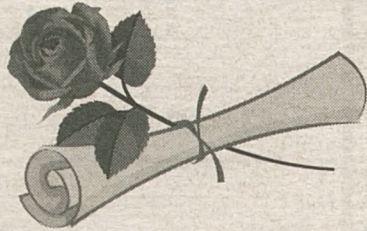

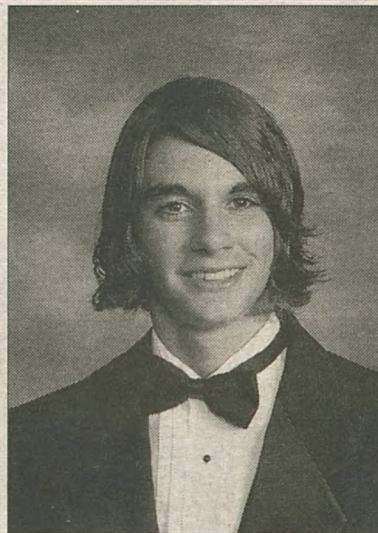

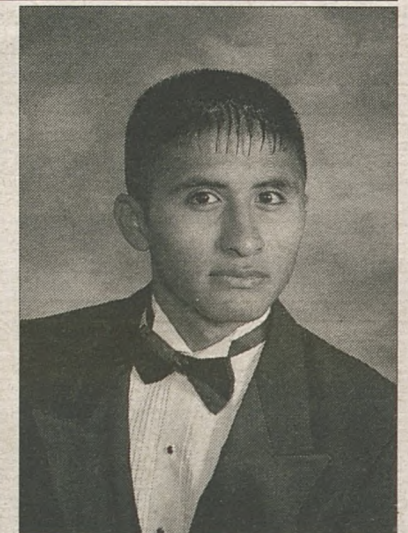
After graduation he plans to attend classes at St. Edwards University and receive a degree in Business.

After graduation she plans to attend Austin Community College to commit to a two-year Paramedic Program. Then will go back to receive her degree as a Registered Nurse.

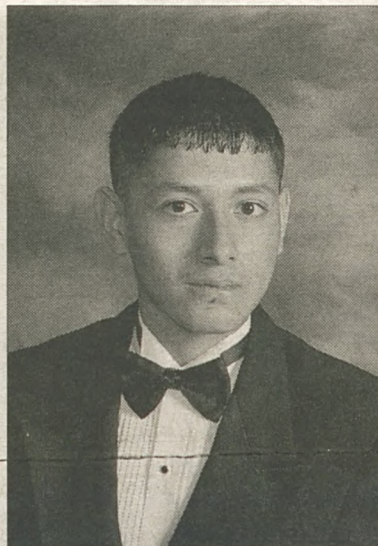


**Guadalupe Vazquez

After graduation he plans to attend Austin Community College for two years and then transfer to University of Texas to pursue a degree in Business Management and minor in Engineering and Technologies.

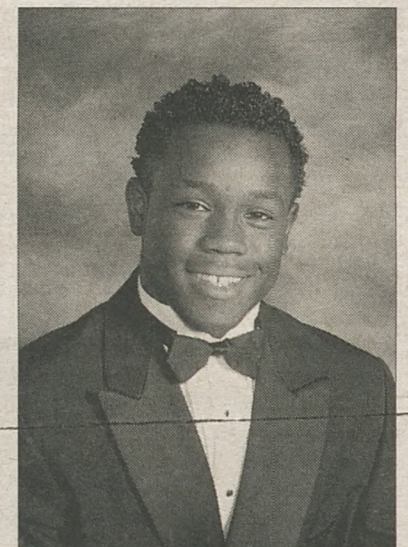


**Courtney Sklar
