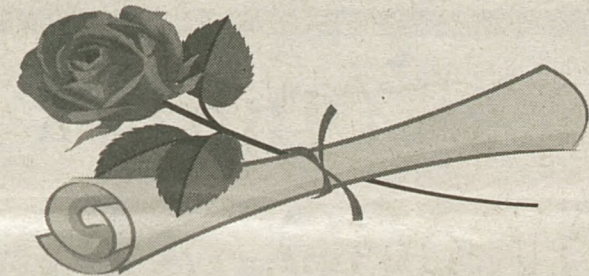


**Alyssa Hernandez**
