The following cadets have been promoted to Cadet Airman:

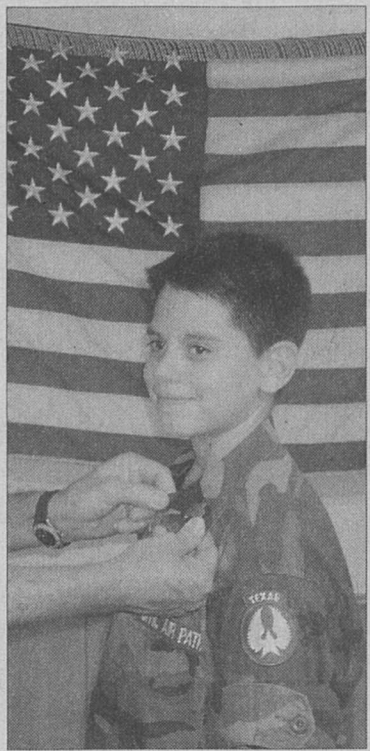

The Tristan siblings, who live in Eagle Lake, joined CAP in March 2007 and have completed their Curry Achievement.

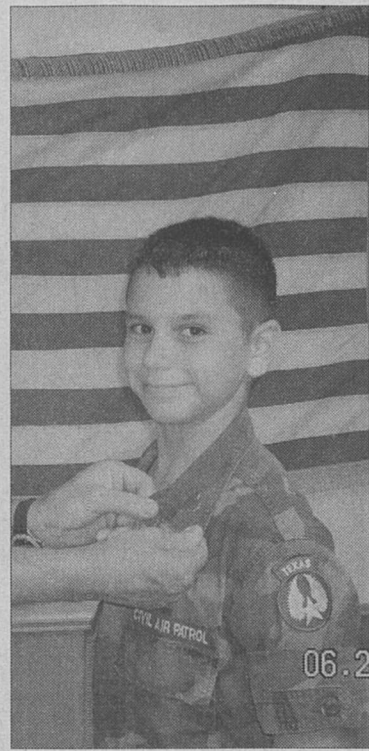
Amber and Jonathan attend Rice High School while Nick attends Eagle Lake Jr. High.

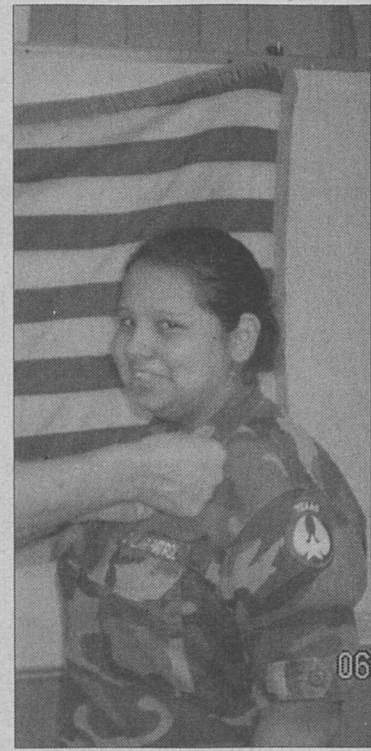

COLORADO COUNTY COURTHOUSE REPORT

Six Lawsuits In District Court

Six lawsuits were filed in Colorado County district court in the past week.

On July 3, SLM Education Credit Finance Corp. filed suit against Anthony E. Carter in a dispute over payment on a promissory note for \$3,850.

Also on July 3, Hudson & Keyse, LLC filed suit against Doris M. Foster in a dispute over a credit account. The amount in dispute is \$18,052.

On July 3, prosecutors filed suit seeking a bond forfeiture in a case in which James C. Schindler failed to appear in court on June 14 on a charge of criminal mischief.

The bond amount was \$5,000.

Prosecutors also filed suit seeking forfeiture of a \$7,500 bond that had been posted for Kelly D. Fulsome on a charge of possession of a controlled substance. The suit claims Fulsome failed to appear in court on June 14.

On July 5, Citibank, South

Dakota, filed suit against Keith A. Klump involving a dispute over a credit account totaling of \$26,940.

On July 10, Chase Manhattan Bank, USA filed suit seeking enforcement an arbitration award of \$9,301 in a dispute with Rafael D. Escobar.
